5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

Who does Jesus invite into the kingdom of heaven? Everyone! We are all invited, but it is up to us to accept His invitation. Luke 14:15-24, The Parable of the Great Feast



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid how they can set aside time for their relationship with Jesus this week. Ask your kid who they might invite to spend time with them this week.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Have you ever felt excluded before?

What are some ways you can work on inviting and including others?

What excuses have you made to not spend time in God's word? What blessings could you have missed out on because of this?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"I was hungry. And you gave me something to eat. I was thirsty. And you gave me something to drink. I was a stranger. And you invited me in. I needed clothes. And you gave them to me. I was sick. And you took care of me. I was in prison. And you came to visit me." Matthew 25:35-36 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

There are two important takeaways from today's lesson. One is to love others the way that Jesus loves them and not to exclude others. The other is to spend our time wisely in a relationship with Jesus. Questions to consider as you help your child take these lessons and make them real: What are some ways that you can work together as a family to be welcoming to your neighbors?
