5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What affect did Jesus have on Zacchaeus? Zacchaeus' heart was changed. He promised to give the money back that he had cheated others out of, and to give half his possessions to the poor. Meeting Jesus changes our hearts. Luke 19:1-10, Zacchaeus the Tax Collector



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if they have noticed any changes in their heart since they've been learning about Jesus.

Ask your kid if there is a time when they remember Jesus meeting them to offer forgiveness and love.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

What qualities of Jesus do you think drew Zacchaeus to Jesus and made him want to climb the tree to see Him?

How can we remain close to Jesus in our desire to be like Him?

What sins or mistakes would you like forgiveness for today?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"I was hungry. And you gave me something to eat. I was thirsty. And you gave me something to drink. I was a stranger. And you invited me in. I needed clothes. And you gave them to me. I was sick. And you took care of me. I was in prison. And you came to visit me." Matthew 25:35-36 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

What are some ways that your family can work to invite outsiders into your inner circle? Providing opportunities for your kids to serve together with you at a local charity or encouraging them to reach out to kids at school who are excluded, are great ways to put what we learned into action! Encourage your kids to always remain connected to Jesus, because it is only by the Holy Spirit working through us, that we can share the love of Jesus with others!
