5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

When the disciples were in trouble and needed help, what happened? Jesus performed a miracle, calming the sea and walking on water. We can have faith that God can help us in times of need too. Matthew 14:22-33, Jesus Walks on the Water



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if anything is keeping them from believing in miracles. Ask your kid how often they pray to God when they need help.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why is it important to go to God in times of trouble?

What is so important about having faith in Jesus?

What are some real stories in the Bible about miracles God has performed?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Jesus replied, 'Things that are impossible with people are possible with God.'" Luke 18:27 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

It can be hard to believe in miracles unless we witness them ourselves. A great way to help one another with our doubts is to share our testimonies so that we can witness what God has done in each other's lives. This helps us to see that miracles didn't just happen in the Old Testament days, but God is still working in and through us now!
