5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What happened when the woman touched Jesus' clothing? She was healed and it was her faith that healed her! We can have faith in Jesus' power too. He is able to do miracles! Mark 5:21-34, Jesus Heals a Sick Woman



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if there is someone in their life they would like to pray for a miracle for. Ask your kid about the last time they asked God for His help?



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

What was so important about the way the woman believed and had faith?

What other miracles can you think of that have happened in the Bible?

Why is it that nothing is impossible for God even when it's impossible for us?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Jesus replied, 'Things that are impossible with people are possible with God.'" Luke 18:27 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

When we pray for a miracle, it is in God's hands. We can't always know the reason why He answers prayers the way He does. Why He answers one prayer right away and another prayer many years later. All we can know is that God is perfect, and He has a perfect will. We can trust in His timing. We can also trust that if we continue to pray and never stop having faith, God can answer our prayers in the perfect way. The woman in Mark 5 was healed 12 years into her ailment. We can keep having faith and praying, even when it takes a long time for our prayers to be answered. Because God is able!
