#### 5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



##### **IN THE CAR:**

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

Does Jesus have power over darkness and evil? Yes! Jesus saved the man from demons. Jesus places His light in us to help us overcome temptations and evil. Mark 5:1-20, Jesus Restores a Demon-Possessed Man



##### **HANGING OUT:**

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid what are the not-so-good parts of their life that they would like Jesus to help them with.

Ask your kid if there are any parts of them that Jesus has already made changes to. Example: Less selfish



##### **AT DINNER:**

Here are some great discussion starters:

What are some evidences that show Jesus is in our hearts? (Hint: Fruit of the Spirit)

What is the only way to become like Jesus? (Hint: Close relationship with who?)

What is the good news about Jesus's power?



##### **AT BEDTIME:**

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Jesus replied, 'Things that are impossible with people are possible with God.'" Luke 18:27 (NIRV)



##### **PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

Talking about demons and evil can be quite a heavy topic for children. But just like the verse says in the Bible to focus on whatever is good, lovely, pure, and praiseworthy; we can put our focus on Jesus' power over darkness. (Philippians 4:8) The way to avoid getting caught up in the fear of evil, is by realizing that Jesus has defeated evil on the cross. By accepting Jesus into our hearts, we allow Him to fill us with love, joy, and peace!
