5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What is the Great Commission? Jesus' mission for us as His followers to go and share the gospel with others around the world. Matthew 28:16-20, The Great Commission



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid what ways they can be a disciple this week.
Ask your kid what ways they can prepare to be able to be a disciple this week.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why is the Great Commission a lot like "game time," and reading God's word a lot like "practice" in sports.

How can we share Jesus with those around us?

What ways would you like to learn and grow before you share Jesus with others? (Hint: What are areas you need help with, such as fear or laziness.)



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Whoever doesn't carry their cross and follow me can't be my disciple." Luke 14:27



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

As we become Jesus' followers, just like the original disciples, it will lead us to a place where we make more disciples. This is the Great Commission that Jesus gave us. If this seems at all overwhelming to your family, it might mean that you aren't yet ready for "Game Time" but you need more "Practice". Encourage your kids to do Bible studies, and prayer times, go to church to learn, and continue to grow in their faith. As we grow closer to Jesus, we are given gifts and abilities to do what God is calling us to do! This comes with time and with practice. Let's first begin sitting with Jesus and getting to know Him so that we have what we need to serve and love others well!
