#### 5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



##### **IN THE CAR:**

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What did Jesus say when the devil tried to tempt Him? He spoke scripture from the Bible and rebuked Satan. He was able to see God's truth and not be tricked by Satan's schemes. We can ask Jesus to help us and go to God's word for the truth when we are tempted. Matthew 4:1-11, Jesus is Tempted in the Wilderness



##### **HANGING OUT:**

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if it's difficult to resist temptation on your own.  
Ask your kid why it's important to know God's word in order to resist temptations.



##### **AT DINNER:**

Here are some great discussion starters:

What are the three temptations the devil gave Jesus in the desert?

Can those things be tempting for us sometimes?

Why is it important to remember that we aren't alone when we are tempted. Who do we need to lean on for strength?



##### **AT BEDTIME:**

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Ask, and it will be given to you. Search, and you will find. Knock, and the door will be opened to you." Matthew 7:7 (NIRV)



##### **PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

In this unit, we will be learning about the things that Jesus said. He gives us so much wisdom about the problems we face. Talk to your kid about how God is with them and that they are never alone. Encourage them to pray to ask God for help during difficulties. It is when we think we are alone that we get ourselves into the most trouble. Help your kids see that Jesus is with them; in a close relationship with Him, He is our strength and courage!
