5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What did Jesus say about doubt? Blessed are those who believe even though they don't see God. We can believe and trust God by getting closer to Him in prayer. This will strengthen our faith and we will feel God working in our hearts. John 20:24-29, Jesus Appears to Thomas



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid why it's difficult to believe what you can't see.
Ask your kid what is one thing they know is real that they can't see.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

How does prayer and reading God's word help us to believe?

What can we do when we doubt?

What does it mean to seek God?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Ask, and it will be given to you. Search, and you will find. Knock, and the door will be opened to you." Matthew 7:7 (NIRV)



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Encourage your child to seek God when they have doubts. They don't need to feel shame when there are doubts; instead, they can do something about them! Go to God! Pray and ask Him for help. Review the memory verse with your child as a reminder to seek God in all things.
