IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

During Jesus' time, were all the rules around the Sabbath made by God? No, most of the rules were made up by religious leaders, the Pharisees. Sometimes the leaders got so caught up in the rules that they forgot about people. Jesus came to show them a better way. Luke 6:6-11, Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath Day



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid why God has given us the Ten Commandments.
Ask your kid what is one way they can rest this Sunday.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why did Jesus say it was okay to heal on the Sabbath?

What is one way we can focus less on man-made rules and more on loving God and others?

Who is someone you would like to help this week? What needs do they have?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in Him will not die but will have eternal life." John 3:16



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

We need to obey God and His commandments, but we also need to see that God didn't make those rules so that we would have an excuse not to love and serve one another. We can sometimes add man-made rules to God's and end up changing them to something God did not intend. The best way to know when we have misinterpreted God's word is by praying and asking God to speak to us through His Holy Spirit. We can also look to the life of Jesus in God's word to see the best example to follow!
