#### 5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



##### **IN THE CAR:**

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

What lesson did Jesus teach the Pharisee who invited Jesus to eat with him? Jesus taught him that forgiveness is a priceless gift. He also taught him that the woman was more grateful for it, because her sin had also been great. Luke 7:36-50, A Sinful Woman Pours Perfume on Jesus



##### **HANGING OUT:**

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid if they have ever thought they had sinned too much for Jesus to forgive. Ask your kid why forgiveness is a priceless gift. (Hint: Leads to eternal life.)



##### **AT DINNER:**

Here are some great discussion starters:

Have you ever felt you were better than someone else? What does this lesson say about that?

What are better ways we can treat other people who are different from us?

When was the last time you thanked Jesus for the priceless gift He has given you?



##### **AT BEDTIME:**

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in Him will not die but will have eternal life." John 3:16



##### **PARENT TIME:**

What you need to know:

In today's lesson, Jesus taught us that we are most likely to be more thankful when we have been forgiven a larger debt. Because of this, it can be difficult for children to understand the fullness of God's grace, because they have yet to make as many mistakes as we have as adults. We can't force thankfulness and gratitude. What we can do is share our testimonies and the reason we are so thankful. We can also read to them stories in the Bible that show God's love for people, even after they have made mistakes. This can help kids to see just how amazing God's love and forgiveness are.
