5 Simple Ways to Make This Week's Lesson Stick



IN THE CAR:

On the drive home, ask your child what he learned about this week:

How can we sum up the 10 commandments? Love God and love others! When Jesus summed up the entire law in these two command, the Sadducee could see that Jesus knew God's truth. Mark 12:28-34, The Greatest Commandment



HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Ask your kid what is the greatest commandment.
Ask your kid to name some things can distract them from focusing on what is important.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

Why do you think the Pharisees didn't like that they could trick Jesus?

What kind of power did the Pharisees and Sadducees have in those days?

Who is more powerful than anyone?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in Him will not die but will have eternal life." John 3:16



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

Practicing the greatest commandment to love God and love others is a wonderful way to encourage your kids in their faith. Show your kids some tangible ways that they can do this.
