NEW KID CHECK-IN/OUT

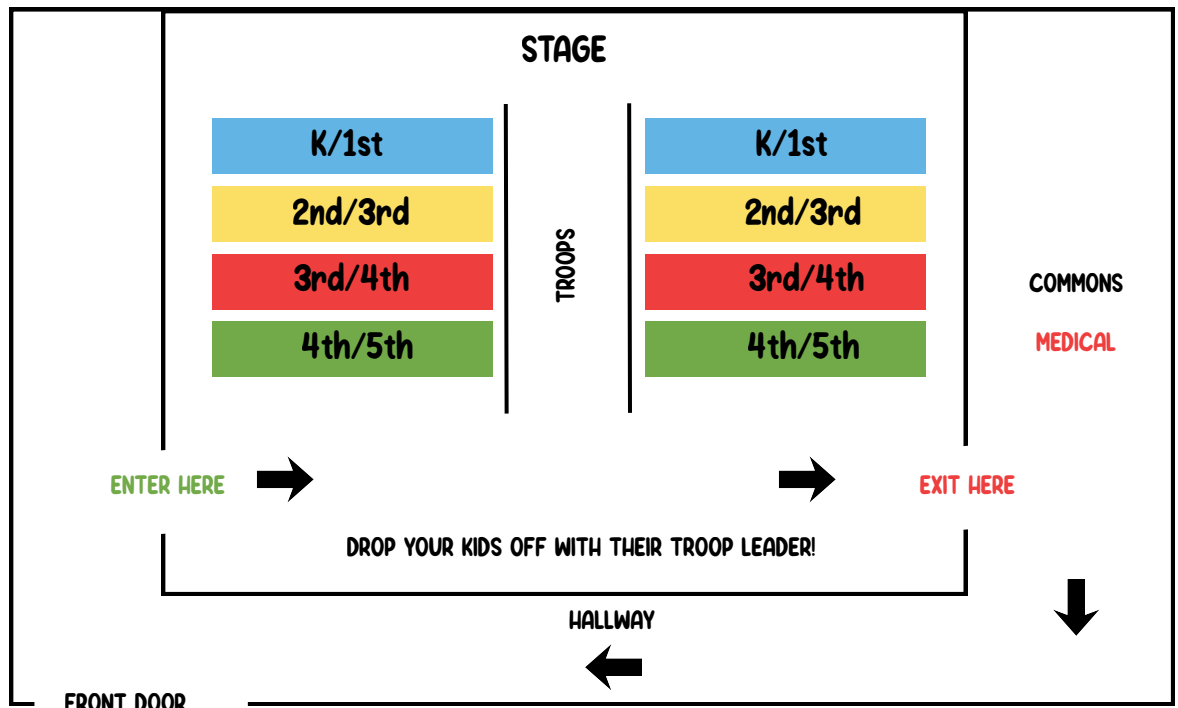


Here at Calvary Chapel Star we are always trying to find ways to improve the safety of your children! This year, when checking your child in, you and your child will receive

a wristband with duplicate numbers. You will need this wristband to check your child out. You will show their troop leader your wristband and once the numbers are matched up, they will cut the wristband off your child and release them to you. You will receive one wristband per child. It's important to note that if someone else is picking up your child, please let the servants know when checking your child in and they will keep these wristbands and the person picking them up will need to show their I.D.

What to Expect (Map)

1. Check your child(ren) in outside at the tables.
2. Walk your child into the gym and drop them off at their troops. Their leader will be holding signs with the animal group they were assigned in. If you aren't sure what group they are in, they will tell you at check-in.
3. Leave out the common doors and go enjoy your child-free day!
4. Check-out: Show your matching wristband to their troop leader and pick up your child.
5. Be excited to hear what they learned about Jesus!
6. Enjoy some quiet while your kid takes a long nap after all the fun they had!
