

Community Camp Platform Dress Code

- Shoes: Anything closed-toed (no flip-flops).
- Tops: Nothing low cut, no tank tops.

 - No shorts, no pants with rips or holes above the knee (unless they are patched underneath).
 - Dresses/skirts should hit below the knee.
- No attire that pushes any agenda other than the Kingdom (i.e. shirts that support a certain political party, candidate, or social movement).
