### **DESCRIPTION:**

The *Worship Crew* will create an atmosphere that allows our students to encounter the presence of God in a tangible way and invites them to respond in a manner that brings Him honor and glory.

### **RELATIONSHIP EXPECTATIONS**

- The *Worship Crew* is expected to report directly to the *Worship Ministry Lead*.
- The *Worship Crew* is expected to engage with COF staff, pastors, volunteers, students, visitors, and Camp Cotubic staff with the utmost respect and handle any conflict in private.
- The loyalty and support to the Pastors and other COF staff (as it pertains to COF mission and values) is required, regardless of one's own philosophies.

## ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES: BEFORE CAMP

- Come prepared with your parts for the worship set(s) assigned to you. Vocal and instrumental tones should emulate the original recordings, unless otherwise directed.
- Participate in Worship Crew meetings leading up to camp.
- Receive and implement feedback from the Worship Ministry Lead and Music Director with humility.
- Be familiar with the Prime arrangements for all songs.
- Come expectant of our students, preparing to minister to them.

## ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES: DURING CAMP

- Arrive early to rehearsals, fully set up and ready before soundcheck begins.
- Come with all vocal/instrumental parts memorized, with a strong grasp of song structure, and the flexibility to improvise or flow as the Worship Leader directs.
- Come physically and spiritually ready to lead the students into worship.
- Support the Worship Leader in leading the room. Stage presence matters—be willing to move, engage, and show genuine enthusiasm.
- Be on time and present for all meetings.
- Be expectant of feedback and remain coachable throughout rehearsal.
- Leave spaces, equipment and gear better than how you found it.
- Pursue excellence: instruments/vocals in tune, lyrics and arrangements fully memorized and internalized.
