## Key Responsibilities:

### 1. Arrival (G - Greet)

- **The production lead sets the tone for the rest of the team, so how you arrive to the team tells them what their expectations are**
  - The standard you model is the standard you expect

- **Be devoted to deepening your relationship with Jesus**
  - We don't just want to train great servants, we want to create disciples
  - **John 15:5** "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing

## 2. Support the Team / Service Execution (I - Initiate, F - Follow Up)

- **Stay Alert:** Pay attention to the flow of the service and anticipate cues before they happen.
- **Collaborate:** Work as a team to manage transitions smoothly and address any unexpected issues.
- **Focus on Jesus:** Remember that every element of production exists to point people to Jesus and support an atmosphere of worship.
- **Follow the lead checklist supplied at your campus to make sure that everything in the morning is accounted for**
  - Sound check, foyer sound, TV's and projectors on, welcoming the team, etc.
- **If someone new is training, share the culture of the team and mission.**
  - Sometimes people want to join because it looks interesting, so capitalize on the interest by sharing the heart behind the team
- **If you notice someone on the team struggling, use that as time for training, culture, and encouragement**
  - This team is family

## 3. Post-Service Wrap-Up (T - Thank)

- **Review:** Discuss what went well and any areas for improvement with the team.
- **Equipment Care:** Power down and store all equipment properly.
- **Reassure the People:** What they did pushed us towards our mission - *To Connect our Communities to the Person of Jesus*
- **Finalize the lead checklist:** Then send a picture of the reverse side into the COF Production Leads group chat
- **Fill out the production feedback form**
  - Feedback is one of our greatest tools, it helps us to not be stagnant, but always looking for ways to improve and serve our communities better
