## **Reflections on Sunday's Sermon**

The New City Catechism—Lord's Day 5

What Else Did God Create?

God created all things by his powerful Word, and all his creation was very good; everything flourished under his loving rule. (Genesis 1:31)

### **Scripture**

#### Hebrews 4:14-16 (ESV)

<sup>14</sup> Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. <sup>16</sup> Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

## **Understanding and Applying**

**1. Recap:** It has been a while since we sat under the book of Hebrews. How were the Hebrew Christians being tempted and how has this shaped the author's message?

2. Doctrine: What are some doctrines/truths that God is communicating to His people?

• Jesus: Why is the author drawing the saints to look to the person and work of Christ?

3. Implications: How should the saints respond given the type of High Priest they have? (vv. 14 and 16)

• **Application:** How do the truths and exhortations of this passage affect your life, worship, and responsibility towards your fellow believers?

4. Prayer: To close, how might the passage shape your prayers?
