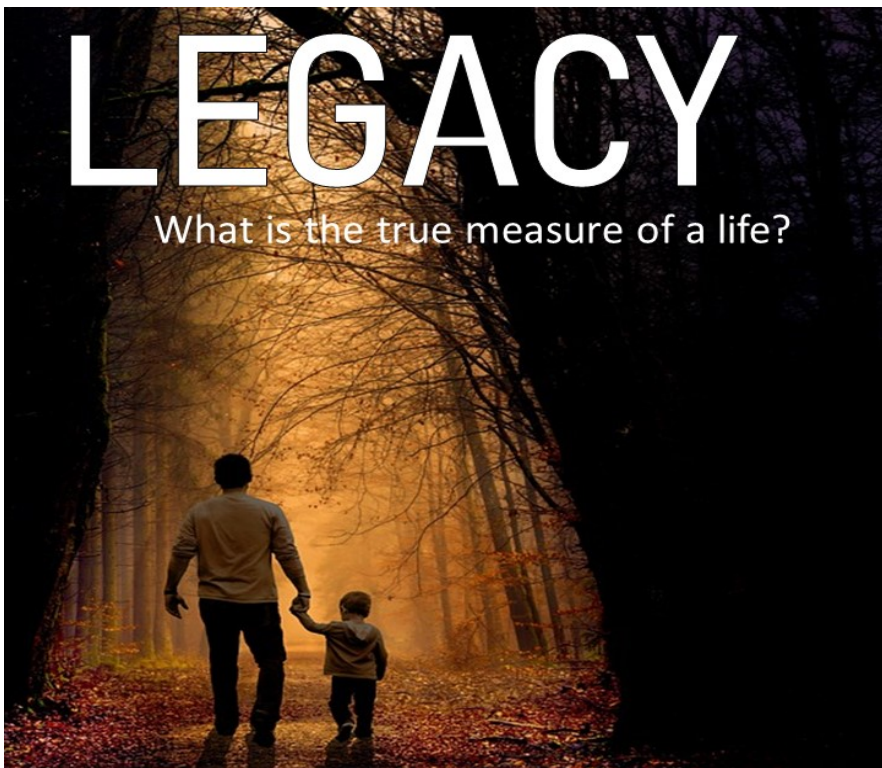

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

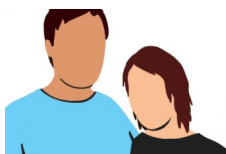
### **MULTIPLY:**

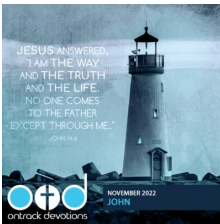
