## LEARNING TO PRAY

### 1 THESSALONIANS 3:11-13

There are between 100 and 150 prayers recorded in the Bible, depending on how individual scholars classify a particular passage.

One takeaway from that fact is that prayer is a major theme of the Scripture. Prayer connects us to God. It allows the believer to both unburden themselves and strengthen themselves almost simultaneously.

Prayer is a way to worship God, give thanks to God, and to discern the will of God. It should be one of the most natural things a Christ-follower can do and yet, most of us learn to pray over time and through the example of others.

This week the apostle Paul will pray for the Thessalonians and there is much for us to learn from it.

### CONNECT

Our text this week represents one of the many prayers found throughout the Bible. With that said, who taught you to pray and what are you still learning about prayer even now?

### GROW

- What stood out the most to you from this week's service, text, or message and why?

- Generally speaking, what is your pattern of personal prayer? Do you pray silently or out loud? Do you sit, get on your knees, or do you pray while also engaging in some other activity? Which member of the Trinity do you address your prayers to and why?

- Paul prayed that the Lord would make them abound in love and that He would establish their hearts blameless in holiness. How would you explain the partnership between God and man in the process of spiritual growth?

What is one practical thing you can do this week to show selfless and sacrificial love to another? How can your Life Group help you with this?






