MATTHEW 26:1-16

Some people argue that Jesus died because He was a victim of His own success. He became too popular and made enemies of powerful people who killed Him when circumstances grew beyond His control.

Nothing could be further from the truth.

In this week's text we will see that Jesus drove every circumstance and every conversation so that He arrived at the Cross exactly when He intended to. Everyone else, from Herod to Caiaphas to Pilate, is a bit player in His story of love and redemption.

It is our prayer that you will be strengthened and encouraged as you see King Jesus sovereignly reigning over those who tried to "oppose" Him.

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 3-22-26

CONNECT

In our text, Jesus is presented with a lavish gift (Matthew 26:6). What is the most meaningful gift you've ever been given and what made it so significant to you?

GROW

- What one aspect of the service, text, or message stood out the most to you and why?

- It is clear from the text that Jesus was the one controlling all the events leading to His death. With that said, how should the sovereignty of God affect your life right now?

- Whatever Judas's motivations were, it is clear he decided to take matters into his own hands. Why might a Christian be tempted to take matters in their own hands (what kind of circumstances, what beliefs, etc.)? What makes waiting on God difficult for most people?

- How do you demonstrate your love for Jesus in a visible, regular, and sacrificial way (you can treat this as 3 different questions)?

MULTIPLY

What is one practical thing you can do this week in response to the sovereignty of God over your life? How can your Life Group help you in this?
