MATTHEW 26:17-29

The popular definition of the word "Passion" would be a strong feeling or desire. The original meaning of the word was pain and suffering.

Therefore, the expression "Passion Week" is better understood as "Suffering Week." Likewise, the expression "The Passion of the Christ" is better understood as the "Suffering of the Christ."

This week we are going to walk through the events that comprise the Last Supper all the way through the death of Jesus Christ. It is our prayer that we will be both broken and built-up as we peer into the sufferings of the Christ who died to purchase the promises of God and who has triumphantly risen again.

CONNECT

The portion of text we looked at this week is often called the Last Supper. With that said, if you knew that your next meal was going to be your last, what would you want to eat? Use as much detail as needed to make others want it as well.

GROW

- What one aspect of the service, text, or message stood out the most to you and why?
- It is our habit to partake in Communion once per month. What is the most meaningful part of Communion to you and why (for instance it could be the elements, the time of quiet prayer and reflection, or the fact that we're participating together)? How does Communion point to the past, the present, and the future?
- In Ezekiel 36 we are told that one consequence of the New Covenant is the replacement of a heart of stone with a heart of flesh. How would you describe the difference between the two? How should that reality affect both evangelism and discipleship?
- What part of Jesus's Passion, from the upper room to the grave, captivates or stirs your heart the most and why? How does that continue to affect your life today?

What is one practical thing you can do this week in response to the sacrificial and substitutional death of Christ for you? How can your Life Group help you with this?
