CALLED TO HOLINESS

1 THESSALONIANS 4:1-8

None of us remember learning to walk, and that's a good thing because it was a painful process.

In one sense, walking seems the most natural thing in the world for a human to do and yet, it requires a difficult set of skills to master.

Learning to walk in practical holiness is a lot like that. In this week's text the apostle Paul is going to tackle the sensitive subject of human sexual expression in order to encourage us toward greater degrees of practical holiness.

Given our nature and our culture, this can be a difficult and painful journey, but God's grace enables us to keep getting back up in our pursuit of holiness.

CONNECT

- What are the best motivations for you to live a holy life and abstain from sexual immorality and why? What does this passage teach you about how God views holiness and why?
- Every human being is born sexually broken. How would you help someone who wanted to repent of their broken sexual expression? What do you do, in pursuit of practical holiness, to maintain sexual purity in your stage of life?
