## **LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 4-2-23**

### **CONNECT:**

Resurrection Sunday marks the most important moment in the history of the world. Apart from the birth, death, and resurrection of Jesus, what would you argue are one or two other most significant dates or events in history and why?

### **GROW:**

- What part of today's text or message stood out the most to you and why?
- Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Passion Week. It is so called because of the passion with which Jesus pursued the cross and because of the pain that He endured in doing so. What is the most painful thing you have ever experienced from a physical or emotional perspective?
- The Pharisees rejected their own Messiah. Why do you think otherwise very intelligent people can miss very important and, in some cases, very obvious truths? What does that say about the need for God's grace in salvation?
- The Pharisees called Jesus "teacher" which, of course, He was, but He was so much more than that. What titles do the Bible ascribe to Jesus? How do you think of Him most often and how do you think that impacts your relationship to Him?

### **SERVE:**

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

### **MULTIPLY:**

What is one practical thing you can do this week to better connect with the events and truths of Passion Week that would build your anticipation for Resurrection Sunday? How can your Life Group help you in this?
