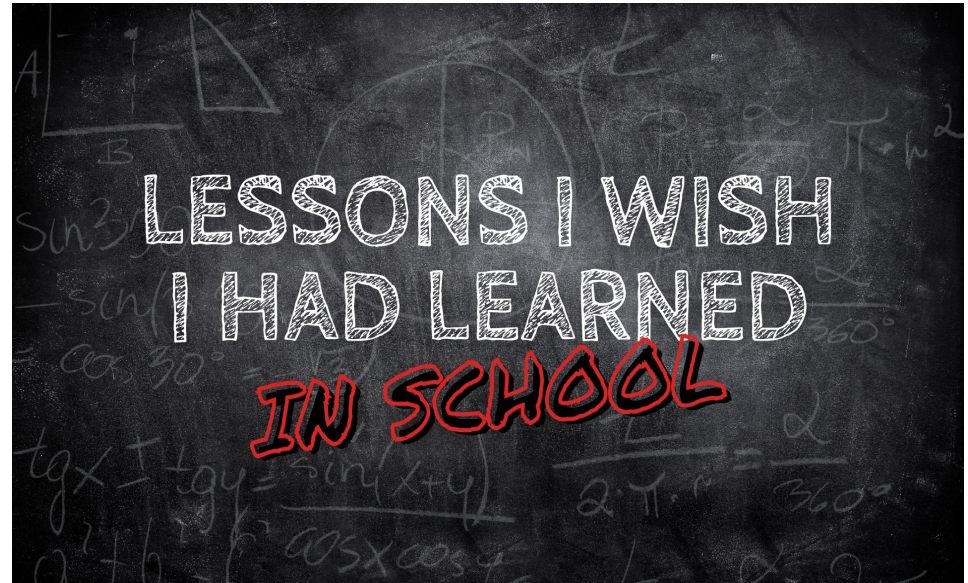

WHAT IS A TRUE FRIEND?

EPHESIANS 4:11-16

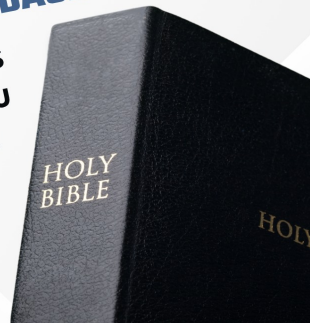
