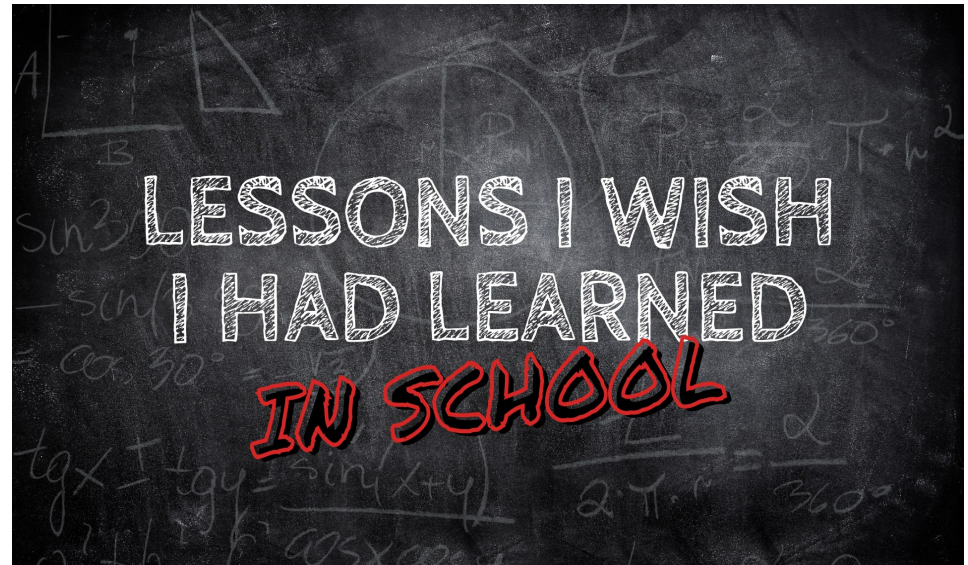

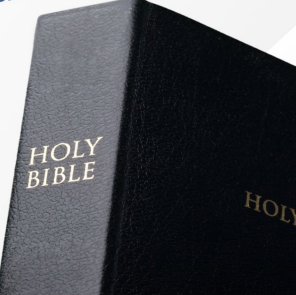

CALL NO PLACE HOME BUT HEAVEN - JOHN 14:1-3

Where have you lived? For many, it's a long story! When we're saved, we learn to call no place home but heaven. John 14:1-3 outlines 2 GIFTS GOD GIVES:

1- HOPE 14:1

He gives perspective.

These 2 commands set up the chapter and take us places. Subtract fear; add faith.

He makes possible.

Along with His expectations, God gives abilities. Jesus feels troubled in spirit when His loved ones suffer in this way, then turns around & invites you to not be troubled.

2- HOME 14:2-3

We have a home.

Christ has designed something perfect and permanent. This is not it. John refers to Christ as "sent" 37 times.

We're going home.

Christ promises to return – and remove us.

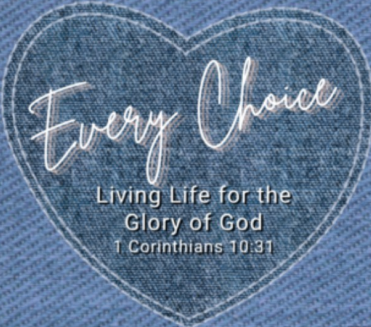
Heb. 11:13-16 – The Hall of Faith honorees mastered this.

Ex. 18:3-4 – Moses named his sons based on this concept.

II Cor. 5:1-9 – We long for home in this same way.

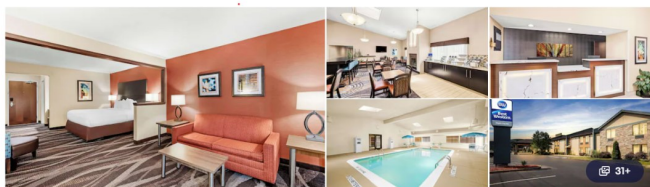
