STEWARDSHIP GOALS BOARD - You may have noticed some updates in the Worship Hall, particularly the addition of our ministry goals blackboard. This board is up to help hold us accountable to some of the stewardship goals we have set as a church. These are goals focused on the upkeep of the building, as well as replacing or updating some of the features of our property. Some of the goals for this year, while others are more long-term, for the next three to five years. Two of the long-term goals you may have noticed are regarding our Building Fund, Capital Fund, and Emergency Response Fund. These are restricted funds which means they are set apart from the general operations of the church and the ongoing ministry. A good way to think about them is as 'emergency funds' or 'rainy day' funds. Below are basic definitions for these two funds and why they exist. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to Pastor Kyle or our Treasurer Linda Ponce.



General Fund: The annual budget for the operation of the church, payroll, ministry expenses, building operations

Building Fund: Serves as a safety net OR as a savings account for expenses directly related to the maintenance of the properties. Should unplanned expenses regarding the building(s) arise, we can pay for them out of the Building Fund. OR should a new need arise for our facility, we can pay for it out of the Building Fund.

Capital Fund: Serves as a safety net OR as a savings account for expenses related to the ministry operations. Should unplanned expenses regarding church ministry arise, we can pay for them out of the Capital Fund OR should a new need arise for ministry, we can pay for it out of the Capital Fund.

Emergency Response Fund: Serves as a financially independent missional arm for the Life Center. Should a disaster or mission opportunity arise, we are able to financially support that act of service without taking from the General Budget. This is separate from monthly mission as this fund is established to meet sudden unexpected emergencies for local, regional, national, or international emergencies.


