Reminders to Participants in Secret Prayer Support

We are so pleased that you elected to join in the SECRET PRAYER SUPPORT program throughout the weeks of Lent. By now you have been praying at least a couple of weeks for the person whose name you drew. You might insert a scripture such as Col. 1:9-12 or Numbers 6:24-26 in your prayers if you "just don't know what to pray" on some days. Along with your prayers, we encourage you to send an unsigned card identifying yourself as "your secret prayer partner" one or two times during Lent to the person you are praying for. This will simply remind your Secret Prayer Partner that he/she IS being prayed for each day and will also add some suspense as to whom you might be. Remember to keep your name a secret until Easter when you send a card identifying yourself. May the Lord bless you as you lift your "secret prayer partner" before Him!
