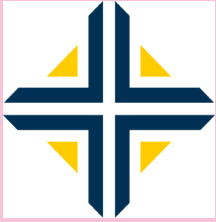

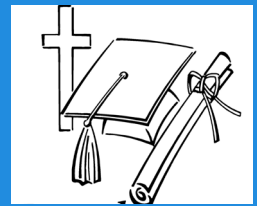

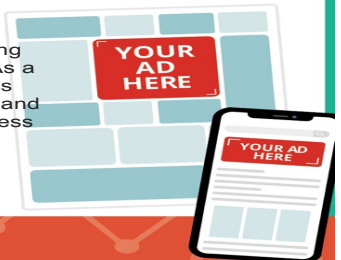
## Dear Trinity Congregation,
