- ¹ Hear this, all you peoples;
listen, all who live in this world,

you understanding.
- ⁴ I will turn my ear to a proverb;
with the harp I will expound my riddle:
- ⁵ Why should I fear when evil days come,
when wicked deceivers surround me—
- ⁶ those who trust in their wealth
and boast of their great riches?
- ⁷ No one can redeem the life of another
or give to God a ransom for them—
- ⁸ the ransom for a life is costly,
no payment is ever enough—
- ⁹ so that they should live on forever
and not see decay.
- ¹⁰ For all can see that the wise die,
that the foolish and the senseless
also perish, leaving their wealth to
others.
- ¹¹ Their tombs will remain their houses
forever, their dwellings for endless

lands after themselves.
- ¹² People, despite their wealth, do not
endure; they are like the beasts that
perish.
- ¹³ This is the fate of those who trust in
themselves, and of their followers,
who approve their sayings.

- ¹⁷ for they will take nothing with them when they die, their splendor will not descend with them.
- ¹⁸ Though while they live they count themselves blessed—and people praise you when you prosper—
- ¹⁹ they will join those who have gone before them, who will never again see the light of life.
- ²⁰ People who have wealth but lack Understanding are like the beasts that perish.

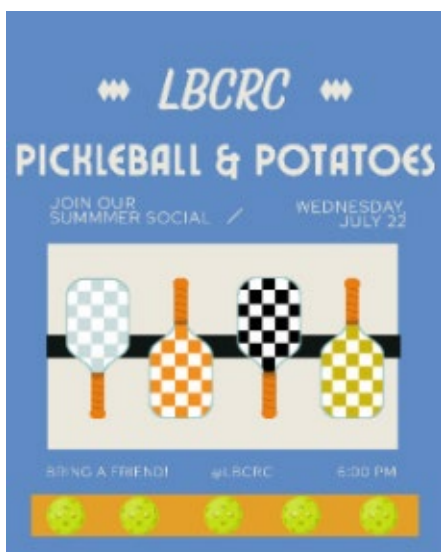
