

1 Jeremiah 31

- 31:31 "See, the days are coming," declares יהוה, "when I shall make a renewed covenant with the house of Yisra'el and with the house of Yehudah,³² not like the covenant I made with their fathers in the day when I strengthened their hand to bring them out of the land of Mitsrayim, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them," declares יהוה.³³ "For this is the covenant I shall make with the house of Yisra'el after those days, declares יהוה: I shall put My Torah in their inward parts, and write it on their hearts. And I shall be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.

2 A Renewed Covenant

3 Dishonor: A Broken Ketubah

- Matt 1:18¹⁸ But the birth of יהושע Messiah was as follows: After His mother Miryam was engaged to Yosēph, before they came together, she was found to be pregnant from the Set-apart Spirit.¹⁹ And Yosēph her husband, being righteous, and not wishing to make a show of her, had in mind to put her away secretly.²⁰ But while he thought about this, see, a messenger of יהוה appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Yosēph, son of Dawid, do not be afraid to take Miryam as your wife, for that which is in her was brought forth from the Set-apart Spirit.²¹" And she shall give birth to a Son, and you shall call His Name יהושע for He shall save His people from their sins.

4 Handwriting Against Her...

- Numbers 5:15 — The husband brings his wife to the priest along with a grain offering.
- Numbers 5:16–18 — The priest brings the woman before the LORD, prepares "holy water" in an earthen vessel, adds dust from the tabernacle floor, and places the grain offering in her hands.
- Numbers 5:19–22 — The priest places her under oath. If she is innocent, the water will not harm her; if she has been unfaithful, the oath invokes a curse.
- Numbers 5:23–26 — The priest writes the curses down, washes them into the bitter water, presents the offering, and has the woman drink.
- Numbers 5:27–28 — Her innocence or guilt is then demonstrated by the outcome.
- Numbers 5:29–31 summarizes the procedure as "the law of jealousy."

5 Why Death?

- Deut 22:23-24 When a girl who is a maiden is engaged to a husband, and a man finds her in the city and lies with her,"²⁴then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city, and shall stone them to death with stones, the girl because she did not cry out in the city, and the man because he has humbled his neighbour's wife. Thus you shall purge the evil from your midst.²⁵"But if a man finds the girl who is engaged in the field, and the man takes hold of her and lies with her, then only the man who lay with her shall die.²⁶But you shall do no matter to the girl. The girl has no sin worthy of death – for the matter is like a man who rises against his neighbour and murders him – a being - " Why Death?
- Joseph: broken Ketubah, Wedding Covenant
- Light or "less weighty" commandments:(qallot) קָלוֹת
- .heavy," "weighty," or "more important" commandments" – (ḥamurot) חֲמוּרוֹת.

6 New Or Renewed...?

- New: Forgiveness to the Gentile Church... Different, Not Like what came before, Torah is Abolished Love is the New LAW.
- Re-Newed: Forgiveness to the People of Israel, Similar but Better then before, it establishes the Torah in Love.
- Ephesians 2:15 having abolished (torah-Moses) in His flesh the enmity – the torah of the commands in dogma – so as to create in Himself one renewed man from the two, thus making peace,
- Col 2:13¹³And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,¹⁴having blotted out that which was written by hand against us (Torah)– by the dogmas – which stood against us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the stake.

7 Ephraim-Israel & Judah-Israel...Bride

- Jer 3:6 And יהוה said to me in the days of Yoshiyahu the sovereign, "Have you seen what backsliding Yisra'el (Ephraim) has done? She has gone up on every high mountain and under every green tree, and there committed whoring.7" And after she had done all these, I said 'Return to Me.' But she did not return. And her treacherous sister Yehudah saw it.8" And I saw that for all the causes for which backsliding Yisra'el had committed adultery, I had put her away and given her a certificate of divorce; yet her treacherous sister Yehudah did not fear, but went and committed whoring too.9" And it came to be, through her frivolous whoring, that she defiled the land and committed adultery with stones and wood.10" And yet for all this her treacherous sister Yehudah has not turned to Me with all her heart, but falsely," declares יהוה.11 And יהוה said to me, "Backsliding Yisra'el has shown herself more righteous than treacherous Yehudah.12" Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say, 'Return, O backsliding Yisra'el,' declares יהוה, 'I shall not look on you in displeasure, for I am lovingly-committed,' declares יהוה, 'and I do not bear a grudge forever.
- Jer 31:3131" See, the days are coming," declares יהוה, "when I shall make a renewed (Ketubah-Wedding) covenant with the house of Yisra'el and with the house of Yehudah,32 not like the covenant I made with their fathers in the day when I strengthened their hand to bring them out of the land of Mitsrayim, My covenant (Ketubah) which they broke, though I was a husband to them," declares יהוה.

8 New - RenewedBetter!

- Why Death?...No Animal Atonement, Better sacrifice was needed
- Heb 10:55 Therefore, coming into the world, He says, "Slaughtering and meal offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me.6" In ascending offerings and offerings for sin You did not delight.7" Then I said, 'See, I come – in the roll of the book it has been written concerning Me – to do Your desire, O Elohim.'8" Saying above, "Slaughter and meal offering, and ascending offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor delighted in," which are offered according to the Torah,9 then He said, "See, I come to do Your desire, O Elohim." He takes away the first (Animal Atonement) to establish the second (Atonement Of Messiah). (Ps40)
- Heb 8:66 But now He (Messiah) has obtained a more excellent service, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better (Ketubah) covenant, which was constituted on better promises.7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second.8 For finding fault with them, (Bride-Broken Ketubah) He says, "See, the days are coming," says יהוה, "when I shall conclude with the house of Yisra'el and with the house of Yehudah (SAME BRIDE) a renewed covenant,.... 10 "Because this is the (Ketubah) covenant that I shall make with the house of Yisra'el after those days, says יהוה, giving My (Same) laws (Ketubah) in their mind (This Time), and I shall write them on their hearts, (This Time) and I shall be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.

9 New Or Renewed....BETTER!

10 How To: Betroth The Same Woman

- Grain Offering:...Holy Water / Earthen Vessel / Dust-earth...Written Curses - washed in holy water-Bitter Water is drunk...Guilty Woman will die: Death!
- John 12:23And יהושע answered them, saying, "The hour has come for the Son of Adam to be esteemed.²⁴" Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain (Offering) of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone. But if it dies, it bears much fruit.
- Gal 3:13Messiah redeemed us from the curse of the Torah, having become a curse for us – for it has been written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs upon a tree."
- 1John 5:6 This is the One that came by water and blood: יהושע Messiah, not only by water, but by water and blood.
- John 19:2828After this, יהושע, knowing that all had been accomplished, in order that the Scripture might be accomplished, said, "I thirst!"²⁹A bowl of sour wine stood there, and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and held it to His mouth. ³⁰So when יהושע took the sour wine He said, "It has been accomplished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit

11 One Bride...Not Two Distinct-Different Ones

- Eph 2:1313But now in Messiah יהושע you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of the Messiah.¹⁴For He is our peace, who has made both one, and having broken down the partition of the barrier,¹⁵having abolished in His flesh the enmity – the torah of the commands in dogma (Division-Hebrew-Gentile)– so as to create in Himself one renewed (Bride) man from the two, thus making peace,¹⁶and to completely restore to favour both of them unto Elohim in one body through the stake, having destroyed the enmity by it.

- Col 2:13¹³And you,(were not part of the Bride) being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision (Gentile) of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,¹⁴having blotted out that which was written by hand against us (Curses-Adultery-Death)– by the dogmas – which stood against us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the stake. (Renewing and Making New and Better the Ketubah adding the Gentiles to it).
