3 Lentil Broken...Veil Torn...Foreshadowing

- Matt 27:50And יהושע cried out again with a loud voice, and gave up His spirit.51And see, the veil of the Dwelling Place was torn in two from top to bottom, (Lentil -Veil)and the earth was shaken, and the rocks were split,52and the tombs were opened, and many bodies of the set-apart ones who had fallen asleep were raised,53and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection, they went into the set-apart city and appeared to many. - Matt 27:2 And Yeshua crying out another time sent Ruach Ha-Qodesh. And behold the sanctuary was broken from two sides, upwards and downwards and the earth shook. And the stones were divided through the middle and the graves were opened and many bodies of the holy ones stood up and lived they went out of their graves: after the resurrection many appeared. "Shepherd (Spain) Dr. Miles Jones" Hebrew Gospels.

4 Messiah & Daniel...Complete End!

- Matt 24:2And יהושע said to them, "Do you not see all these? Truly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, at all, which shall not be thrown down." Steph: "Laid waste"
- Daniel 9:27 "And he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week. And in the middle of the week he shall put an end to slaughtering and meal offering. And on the wing of abominations he shall lay waste, even until the complete end and that which is decreed is poured out on the one who lays waste."
- Luke 21:24And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Yerushalayim shall be trampled underfoot by the nations until the times of the nations are filled.
- Rom 11:2525For I do not wish you to be ignorant of this secret, brothers, lest you should be wise in your own estimation, that hardening in part has come over Yisra'el, until the completeness of the nations has come in.26And so all Yisra'el shall be saved, as it has been written, "The Deliverer shall come out of Tsiyon, and He shall turn away wickedness from Ya'aqob,27and this is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins."

- Matt 21:38 "But when the farmers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him, and let us possess his inheritance.' 39 "And they took him, and threw him out of the vineyard, (Jerusalem-Temple) and killed him... 41 They said to Him, "Evil ones! He shall bring them to evil destruction, and lease the vineyard to other farmers (faithful Jew-Gentiles) who shall give to him the fruits in their seasons."

5 Revival Among Israel... 120yrs +

- Eusebius of Caesarea (The "Father of Church History")... shows that for nearly 70 years after the resurrection, the "mother church" remained ethnically and culturally Jewish, even after the destruction of the Temple in 70 AD. Ecclesiastical History, Book IV, Chapter 5.
- Hegesippus (c. 110–180 AD) His memoirs (preserved in fragments by Eusebius) describe the "peace" of the early church under the leadership of the family of Jesus. He notes that the relatives of Jesus (the Desposyni) were leaders in the Judean congregations and were even interrogated by Emperor Domitian, who eventually released them as "harmless peasants." Ecclesiastical History, Book III.
- Justin Martyr (c. 100–165 AD) Justin makes a crucial admission: he acknowledges that there are still many "Jewish Christians" who believe in Jesus as the Messiah while continuing to observe the Law of Moses (Torah). Dialogue with Trypho, Chapter 47
- Persecution: Judaism-Sanhedrin... 40 yrs... 70 AD "But when the farmers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him, and let us possess his inheritance (3 Attempts to rebuild Temple-Worship... Today 4th!)"

6 (1) "Kito Wars" 115-117AD

- "Kito Wars" many Messiahs Get back Jerusalem and Restore temple Service... regional uprising / The most "messianic" figure of the Kitos War was a man named Lukuas (sometimes called Andreas in Greek sources). He led the uprising in Cyrene (modern-day Libya).. Judea Pappus and Lulianos.
- Trajan's general, Lusius Quietus (hence "Kitos"), suppressed the rebellion with extreme force. The Romans maintained a tight grip on the ruins, preventing any formal building. Eusebius of Caesarea's Ecclesiastical History (Book IV) and the Talmud (mentions of the "War of Quietus").

7 (2) False Prophet / False Messiah 132-135AD

- Rabbi Akiva (c. 50–135 AD) was one of the most influential Jewish sages of his time. During the Bar Kokhba revolt, he publicly supported Simon bar Kokhba and identified him as the long-awaited Messiah... Rabbi Akiva interpreted Numbers 24:17 ("a star shall come out of Jacob") as referring to him, Because of this, he gave him the name "Bar Kokhba", meaning "Son of the Star."
- Simon bar Kokhba led a highly successful guerrilla war that actually managed to establish an independent Jewish state for three years. Coins were minted during this period depicting the Temple facade and the words "For the Freedom of Jerusalem...Altar Hadrian sent six full legions to crush the revolt. Following the Roman victory, Hadrian didn't just stop the rebuilding; he attempted to erase the Jewish connection to the land by renaming the province Syria Palaestina (Palestine- Aleia Capitolina) and building a pagan temple to Jupiter on the Temple Mount.

8 Hadrian...Temple To Jupiter...Capitolina

- Jupiter...200-250Yrs
- God Of Rome was worshipped!
- Same god offered to in 70AD by Titus.
- 300s-400s...Christianity begins tearing it down
- Yah's presence left...Removed, another Proclaimed itself God!

9 (3) Julian The Apostate, 363 AD

- .Emperor Julian, who rejected Christianity in favor of Hellenic paganism, sought to undermine the Christian "triumph" by proving the prophecy of the Temple's permanent destruction wrong. Julian issued an imperial edict allowing the Jews to return and rebuild. He even provided state funding and materials.
- Why don't the "Jews" offer sacrifice like all other "Pagan" religions...We can only offer sacrifice in Jerusalem...temple.
- .Ammianus Marcellinus (a contemporary pagan historian) in his Res Gestae (Book XXIII) and the letters of Julian himself.
