

# 1 On That Day

## 2 Same Day They Came Out Of Egypt... 15th

- Ex 19:1 In the third month after the children of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on the same day, they came to the Wilderness of Sinai.(15th) 2For they had departed from Rephidim, had come to the Wilderness of Sinai, and camped in the wilderness. So Israel camped there before the mountain.3And Moses went up to God, (16th) and the Lord called to him from the mountain, saying, "Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel: 4'You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself. 5Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. 6And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

## 3 Two Schools of Thought...Zadok / Rabbi

- Ex 19:1 In the third month after the children of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on the same day, they came to the Wilderness of Sinai.(15th)
- Talmud-Rabbinical: 1st Day of the third month... Mishnah-200CE (Rosh hashanah / Meachot / Hagigah) agricultural, not Sinai revelation day.
- Babylonian Talmud 500-600CE
- Torah Not Given on Shavuot, Season of the Giving Of The Torah "Zman Matan Toratenu"
- Jubilees-Zadok: Third Month on the same day (date) that the children of Israel Left Egypt. 200-150BC
- Covenant Renewals, Feast Of Weeks, Noah's Establishment of it, Eternal ordinance, Celebrated in Heaven before earth, observed yearly in third month on a specific date 15th. Abraham, Isaac, Jacob also celebrated it, Lost in Egypt!

## 4 Elohim Has A Schedule...Appointed Times

- Exodus 12:40 Now the sojourn of the children of Israel who lived in Egypt was four hundred and thirty years. 41And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years—on that very same day (14th-15th-Sojourn of Israel & Exodus Egypt)—it came to pass that all the armies of the Lord went out from the land of Egypt. 42It is a night (14th-15th) of solemn observance to the Lord for bringing them out of the land of Egypt. This is that night of the Lord, a solemn observance for all the children of Israel throughout their generations.
- Not 430 years in Egypt...But From the Making of Covenant With Abraham!

- Septuagint;..."The sojourning of the children of Israel and their fathers, which they sojourned in the land of Egypt and in the land of Canaan, was 430 years."

- Gal 3:13 Messiah redeemed us from the curse of the Torah, having become a curse for us – for it has been written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs upon a tree." –14in order that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the nations in Messiah יהושע, to receive the promise of the Spirit through belief.15Brothers, as a man I say it: a covenant, even though it is man's, yet if it is confirmed, no one sets it aside, or adds to it.16But the promises were spoken to Abraham, and to his Seed.(15th Day Month) He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Messiah.17Now this I say, Torah,(Covenant-15th) that came four hundred and thirty years later, does not annul a covenant previously confirmed by Elohim in Messiah, so as to do away with the promise.
- Gen 15:13 And He said to Abram, "Know for certain that your seed are to be sojourners in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them, and they shall afflict them four hundred years.14"But the nation whom they serve I am going to judge, and afterward let them come out with great possessions...18 On the same (14-15th ) day יהוה made a covenant with Abram, saying, "I have given this land to your seed, from the river of Mitsrayim to the great river, the River Euphrates,

- Gen 21:8And the child grew and was weaned, and Abraham made a great feast on the day that Yitshaq was weaned.9And Sarah saw the son of Haḡar the Mitsrian, whom she had borne to Abraham, mocking

  - Isaacs Birth was on Passover Gen 17:21"But My covenant I establish with Yitshaq, whom Sarah is to bear to you at this appointed time next year."
  - Lot Spared (15th)- unleavened Bread

## 8 Noah-Abraham-Isaac-Jacob...Moses

- Job 1:1 And it came to pass in the first year of the exodus of the children of Israel out of Egypt, in the third month, on the sixteenth day of the month, [2450 Anno Mundi] that God spake to Moses, saying: 'Come up to Me on the Mount, and I will give thee two tables of stone of the law and of the commandment, which I have written, that thou mayst teach them.'
- Job 6:1 And on the new moon of the third month he (Noah) went forth from the ark, and built an altar on that mountain. And he made atonement for the earth, and took a kid and made atonement by its blood for all the guilt of the earth; for everything that had been on it had been destroyed, save those that were in the ark with Noah. And Noah and his sons swore that they would not eat any blood that was in any flesh, and he made a covenant before the Lord God for ever throughout all the generations of the earth in this month. 11. On this account He spake to thee that thou shouldst make a covenant with the children of Israel in this month upon the mountain with an oath, and that thou shouldst sprinkle blood upon them because of all the words of the covenant, which the Lord made with them for ever. And this whole festival was celebrated in heaven from the day of creation till the days of Noah -twenty-six jubilees and five weeks of years [1309-1659 A.M.]: and Noah and his sons observed it for seven jubilees and one week of years, till the day of Noah's death, and from the day of Noah's death his sons did away with (it) until the days of Abraham, and they eat blood

## 9 Jacob-Israel Celebrated It!

- 44;1And Israel took his journey from Haran from his house on the new moon of the third month, and he went on the way of the Well of the Oath, and he offered a sacrifice to the God of his father Isaac on the seventh of this month.And Jacob remembered the dream that he had seen at Bethel, and he feared to go down into Egypt.And while he was thinking of sending word to Joseph to come to him, and that he would not go down, he remained there seven days, (14) if perchance he could see a vision as to whether he should remain or go down.And he celebrated the harvest festival of the first-fruits (15th) with old grain, for in all the land of Canaan there was not a handful of seed [in the land], for the famine was over all the beasts and cattle and birds, and also over man.And on the sixteenth the Lord appeared unto him, and said unto him, 'Jacob, Jacob'; and he said, 'Here am I.' And He said unto him: 'I am the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham and Isaac; fear not to go down into Egypt, for I will there make of thee a great nation I will go down with thee, and I will bring thee up (again), and in this land shalt thou be buried, and Joseph shall put his hands upon thy eye. But Abraham observed it, and Isaac and Jacob and his children observed it up to thy days, and in thy days the children of Israel forgot it until ye celebrated it anew on this mountain.
