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2 Luke 22

- 22:15 And He said to them, "With desire I have desired to eat this Pěsaḥ with you before My suffering,¹⁶ for I say to you, I shall certainly not eat of it again until it is filled in the reign of Elohim." ¹⁷ And taking the cup, giving thanks, He said, "Take this and divide it among yourselves,¹⁸ for I say to you, I shall certainly not drink of the fruit of the vine until the reign of Elohim comes." ¹⁹ And taking bread, giving thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you, do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁰ Likewise the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the renewed covenant in My blood which is shed for you.

3 Passover Is a Prophecy...Teaching

- Ex 12:7.7' And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.
- 22 "And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin,
- 8' And they shall eat the flesh on that night, roasted in fire – with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it

4 New "Re-Newed" Covenant

- Jn 31:31 "See, the days are coming," declares יהוה, "when I shall make a renewed covenant with the house of Yisra'el and with the house of Yehuḏah,
- Ezek 16:60 "But I shall remember My covenant with you in the days of your youth, and I shall establish an everlasting covenant with you.⁶¹ And you shall remember your ways and be ashamed, when you receive your older and your younger sisters. And I shall give them to you for daughters, though not by your own covenant.⁶² And I Myself shall establish My covenant with you. And you shall know that I am ⁶³ יהוה, so that you remember. And you shall be ashamed, and never open your mouth any more because of your shame, when I pardon you for all you have done," declares the Master יהוה.'
- Matt 26:27 ²⁷ And taking the cup, and giving thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you.²⁸ For this is My blood, that of the renewed covenant, which is shed for many for the forgiveness of sins.

5 Not The First New Covenant-Blessing-Seed

- Abraham...Gen 15:18 On the same day יהוה made a covenant with Abram, saying, "I have given this land to your seed, from the river of Mitsrayim to the great river, the River Euphrates,... Gen 22:16¹⁶and said, "By Myself I have sworn, declares יהוה, because you have done this, and have not withheld your son, your only son,¹⁷that I shall certainly bless you, and I shall certainly increase your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore, and let your seed possess the gate of their enemies.¹⁸And in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice.

6 New Covenant At Mount Sinai..Horeb-Wilderness

- Ex 24:3And Mosheh came and related to the people all the Words of יהוה and all the right-rulings. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the Words which יהוה has spoken we shall do."⁴And Mosheh wrote down all the Words of יהוה, and rose up early in the morning, and built a slaughter-place at the foot of the mountain, and twelve standing columns for the twelve tribes of Yisra'el.⁵And he sent young men of the children of Yisra'el, and they offered ascending offerings and slaughtered slaughterings of peace offerings to יהוה of bulls.⁶And Mosheh took half the blood and put it in basins, and half the blood he sprinkled on the slaughter-place.⁷And he took the Book of the Covenant and read in the hearing of the people. And they said, "All that יהוה has spoken we shall do, and obey."⁸And Mosheh took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, and said, "See, the blood of the covenant which יהוה has made with you concerning all these Words."

7 New Covenant In Moab, The Land

- Ex 29:1 These are the words of the covenant which יהוה commanded Mosheh to make with the children of Yisra'el in the land of Mo'ab, besides the covenant which He made with them in Horeb.
- Debt 29:10"All of you are standing today before יהוה your Elohim: your leaders, your tribes, your elders and your officers, all the men of Yisra'el,¹¹your little ones, your wives, and your sojourner who is in the midst of your camp, from the one who cuts your wood to the one who draws your water,¹²so that you should enter into covenant with יהוה your Elohim, and into His oath, which יהוה your Elohim makes with you today,¹³in order to establish you today as a people for Himself, and He Himself be your Elohim, as He has spoken to you, and as He has sworn to your fathers, to Abraham, to Yitshaq, and to Ya'aqob.¹⁴And not with you alone I am making this covenant and this oath,"¹⁵but with him who stands here with us today before יהוה our Elohim, as well as with him who is not here with us today.

8 New Covenant...David Eternal Throne

- 2 Samuel 7:12-13 "When your days are filled and you rest with your fathers, I shall raise up your seed after you, who comes from your inward parts, and shall establish his reign.13" He does build a house for My Name, and I shall establish the throne of his reign forever.14" I am to be his Father, and he is My son. If he does perversely, I shall reprove him with the rod of men and with the blows of the sons of men.15" But My loving-commitment does not turn aside from him, as I turned it aside from Sha'ul, whom I removed from before you.16" And your house and your reign are to be steadfast forever before you – your throne is established forever."

9 Did Any New Covenant Annul The Prior?

- Another New Covenant: Jer 31:31 "See, the days are coming," declares יהוה, "when I shall make a renewed covenant with the house of Yisra'el and with the house of Yehudah,.. 33 "For this is the covenant I shall make with the house of Yisra'el after those days, declares יהוה: I shall put My Torah in their inward parts, and write it on their hearts. And I shall be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.
- Gal 3:15-16 Brothers, as a man I say it: a covenant, even though it is man's, yet if it is confirmed, no one sets it aside, or adds to it.16 But the promises were spoken to Abraham, and to his Seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as of one, "And to your Seed," who is Messiah.17 Now this I say, Torah, that came four hundred and thirty years later, does not annul a covenant previously confirmed by Elohim in Messiah, so as to do away with the promise.
- 3:29 And if you are of Messiah, then you are seed of Abraham, and heirs according to promise..
- Son Of David...lk 18:37 And they reported to him that יהושע of Natsareth was passing by.38 And he cried out, saying, "יהושע, Son of Dawid, have compassion on me!"

10 Why Do We Annul The Torah...Moses

- We are not under the Torah... "Blessings-Life / Cursing-Death"
- Passover Messiah Died...We Die with him...Wage of Sin-Death (Curse)
- We are not under the Curse (Death)...We died already Rom 7:44 So my brothers, you also were put to death to the Torah through the body of Messiah, for you to become another's, the One who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to Elohim..
- Gal 3:13-14 Messiah redeemed us from the curse of the Torah, having become a curse for us – for it has been written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs upon a tree." –14 in order that the blessing of Abraham (All The Covenants) might come upon the nations in Messiah יהושע, to receive the promise of the Spirit (Put The Torah In Our Hearts) through belief.

- Rom 11:16¹⁶Now if the first-fruit is set-apart, the lump is also. And if the root is set-apart, so are the branches.¹⁷And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, have been grafted in among them, and came to share the root and fatness of the olive tree,¹⁸do not boast against the branches. And if you boast, remember: you do not bear the root, but the root bears you!
- Remember The Covenant.....!
