2 John 20: 24-29

- 20:24 But T'oma, called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when יהושע came,²⁵so the other taught ones said to him, "We have seen the Master." But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the mark of the nails, and put my finger into the imprint of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I shall by no means believe."²⁶And after eight days His taught ones were again inside, and T'oma with them. יהושע came, the doors having been shut, and He stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!"²⁷Then He said to T'oma, "Bring your finger here, and see My hands. And bring your hand and put it into My side – and do not be unbelieving, but believing."²⁸And T'oma answered and said to Him, "My Master and my Elohim!"²⁹יהושע said to him, "T'oma, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

3 Why Should We Celebrate The Feasts?

- Jewish Feasts? Judaism: Judah
- Hebrew Feasts, Israelite Feasts... "Hebraism"Yah's Feast (Yahism)
- Lev 23:11And יהוה spoke to Mosheh, saying,²"Speak to the children of Yisra'el, and say to them, 'The appointed times of יהוה, which you are to proclaim as set-apart gatherings, My appointed times, are these:
- Sabbath, Passover-Unleavened Bread, First Fruits, (Spring Feasts)
- Story Of: Escape From Slavery!
- Zadok Calendar...Dead Sea Scrolls

4 The Exodus...Prophecy!

- Rev. 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him, but he said to me, "See, do not do it! I am your fellow servant, and of your brothers who possess the witness of יהושע. Worship Elohim! For the witness of יהושע is the spirit of prophecy."
- Ex 12:2 This new moon (Month) is the beginning of new moons (Months) for you, it is the first new moon (Month) of the year for you. (Abib/Nisan).³ Speak to all the congregation of Yisra'el, saying, 'On the tenth day of this new moon each one of them is to take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household...

- 6'And you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same new moon (Month). Then all the assembly of the congregation of Yisra'el shall slay it between the evenings.

- Lk 22:7 And the Day of Unleavened Bread came when the Pěsaḥ had to be slaughtered 8And He sent Kěpha and Yoḥanan, saying, "Go and prepare the Pěsaḥ for us to eat."13And going they found it as He had said to them, and they prepared the Pěsaḥ... 19.19And taking bread, giving thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you, do this in remembrance of Me." 20Likewise the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the renewed covenant in My blood which is shed for you. (Zadok 14th-Tuesday)

6 Passover-Unleavened Bread (15th)

- Ex 12:31Then he called for Mosheh and Aharon by night, and said, "Arise, go out from the midst of my people, both you and the children of Yisra'ěl. And go, serve יהוה as you have said... 34 And the people took their dough before it was leavened, having their kneading bowls bound up in their garments on their shoulders...(15th) Wednesday
- Jn18:28 Then they led יהושע from Qayapha to the palace, and it was early.(Morning 15th) And they themselves did not go into the palace, lest they should be defiled, but that they might eat the Pěsaḥ..
- Mark 13:25.25 And it was the third hour, and they impaled Him. (15th Abib) Wednesday
- In The Grave 15th Abib...Wednesday

7 Third Day...Encamped!...No Moedim!

- Num 13:3So they departed from Ra'meses in the first new moon, on the fifteenth day of the first new moon, on the morrow of the Pěsaḥ the children of Yisra'ěl went out with boldness before the eyes of all the Mitsrites
- 15th Ramases-Succot
- 16 Succot-Etham
- 18th Encamped-Red Sea (18th 3rd Day)-Into-Sunday
- 19th-Red Sea /?????
- 21-22nd Red Sea (End Unleavened Bread)???
- Pharaoh Pursues!-dies

8 18th Camping -Red Sea? Resurrection!

- Ex 14:9.9And the Mitsrites pursued them, and all the horses and chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen and his army, and overtook them camping by the sea beside Pi Hahiroth, before Ba'al Tsephon (3days Camp-18th-19thSunday / ?21st?) (19th-Resurrection)14:21. And Mosheh stretched out his hand over the sea. And יהוה caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea into dry land, and the waters were divided... 3131And Yisra'el saw the great work which יהוה had done in Mitsrayim, and the people feared יהוה, and believed יהוה and His servant Mosheh. (8th day after Unleavened Bread Week-Sunday-Count Ohmer!)
- Lk 24;20and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and impaled Him.21We, however, were expecting that it was He who was going to redeem Yisra'el. But besides all this, today is the third day since (3 Past-19th of Abib 1st Day of week) these matters took place.
- a19When therefore it was evening on that day,(19th abib) day one of the week, and when the doors were shut where the taught ones met, for fear of the Yehudim, יהושע came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace to you."20And having said this, He showed them His hands and His side.
- 26And after eight days (3rd 19-26th Abib-Sunday) His taught ones were again inside, and T'oma with them. יהושע came, the doors having been shut, and He stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!"27Then He said to T'oma, "Bring your finger here, and see My hands. And bring your hand and put it into My side – and do not be unbelieving, but believing."28And T'oma answered and said to Him, "My Master and my Elohim!"29יהושע said to him, "T'oma, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."
- Lev 23:6'And on the fifteenth day of this new moon is the Festival of Matzot to יהוה – seven days you eat unleavened bread...15-21 day..7 'On the first day (Sunday-After-26thAbib) you have a set-apart gathering, you do no servile work. First-Fruits

9 First Fruits-26th 1st Day "Sunday"

- Sadducees...1st Sabbath during the week of unleavened bread (1st day of week Sunday of Passover-unleavened bread week-variable dates)
- Pharisees... the 16th of (2nd Day Of Passover-Never a 1st day of the week Sunday) Nissan/Abib after the high Sabbath
- Modern Jews / rabbinical Judaism: do not celebrate first fruits, but hold the pharisaic teaching of the 16th (2nd Day of Passover-Never A 1st day of the week Sunday) to begin counting the homer to Shavuot
- Christianity: Sunday during the week of Passover, at the resurrection. (First Fruits)

- Essenes-Zadok Priests... 1st day of the week after the week of passover/ unleavened bread (26- of Abib-1st day of the week "Sunday").
- John20:1And on day one of the week (Sunday 19th Abib) Miryam from Maḡdala came early to the tomb, while it was still dark,...19 When therefore it was evening on that day, day one of the week,(Sunday 19th Abib) and when the doors were shut where the taught ones met, for fear of the Yehudim, יהושע came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace to you!"...24 But T'oma, called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when יהושע came,...26And after eight days (26th Abib Sunday-First Fruits) His taught ones were again inside, and T'oma with them. יהושע came, the doors having been shut, and He stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!"
- Sunday ("19th" 1), Monday(2), Tuesday (3), Wednesday (4), Thursday (5), Friday (6), Saturday-Shabbat (7), Sunday -8th days from the third day Resurrection on 19th is Abib 26th -First Fruits ...First Fruits to those who don't see and yet believe!
