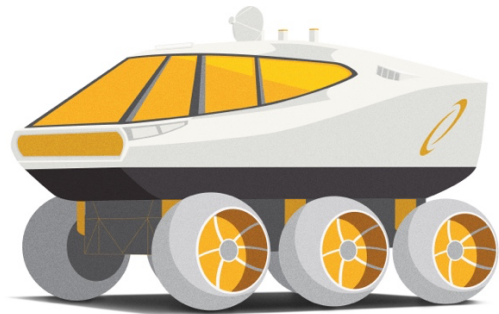
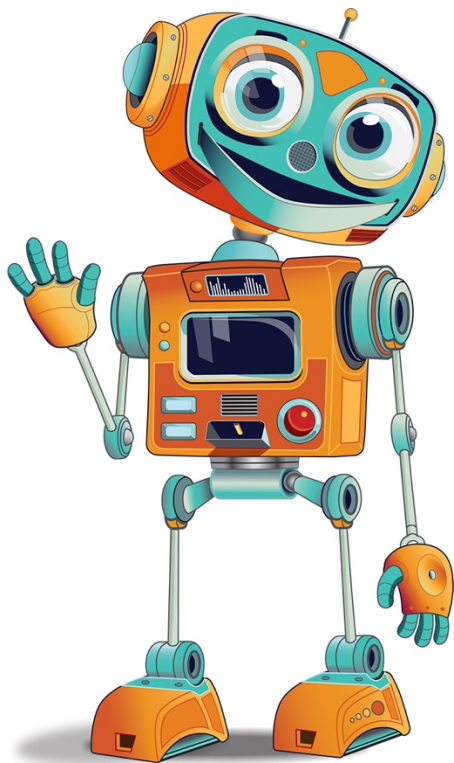

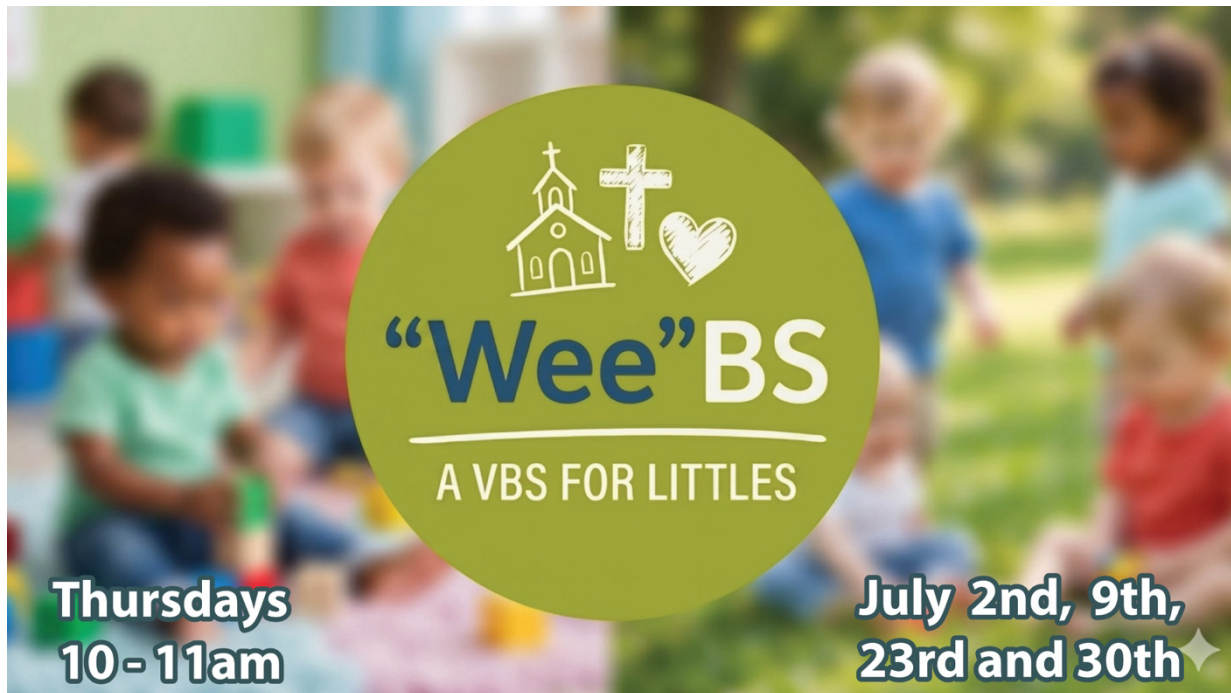
# Q & A

- **Will we have working vacuums for clean up?** *Yes, and we'll ask for the janitorial company to come on Tuesday night instead of Monday night.*
