Constitution Revision Updates

1-The final draft of the proposed revisions to the MVBC Church Constitution is now in the Welcome Center and church office foyer. Please note that there have been two added changes to the first draft based on feedback from church members during the comment period. The two changes are highlighted on the cover sheet attached to the final draft.

2-The Deacon Council invites all MVBC members who could not attend the question-and-answer sessions in February and March to join us for “A Walk Through the Constitution Revisions,” a page-by-page review of all proposed revisions to the MVBC Church Constitution. The review session will be held in the sanctuary at 6:00pm on Wednesday, April 22.

3-The church vote to approve the revisions will be held on Sunday, April 26.
