Hey parents of 9th to 12th graders, we're excited to invite you to a meeting about a fantastic youth-led mission trip to Anchorage, Alaska, from July 25-August 1, 2026! We'll be meeting in room 1122 (right next to the Worship Center) on Sunday, March 22, 2026, right after the 10:30am Worship service.

MVBC is teaming up with Graceworks Alaska to spread the Gospel to children, teens, and adults in Alaska. This trip is for a maximum of 15 people, including adult leaders. Alaska is a truly diverse state, and it's also one of the least reached with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Our teens and adults will be working with Graceworks to run a week-long day camp for children in one of Anchorage's community parks. It'll be a fun, VBS-like experience with Bible stories, singing, games, crafts, and snacks. Graceworks also provides meals for the children in the parks and MVBC's youth will help prepare and serve them.
