POSITION DESCRIPTION

- ❖ The Marshall Ministry Associate Director will work primarily with the Marshall Ministry Director to develop ministry goals and plans for Marshall and surrounding communities.
- ❖ They will be responsible for leading and maintaining community and teams in Marshall.
- ❖ They must have a teachable spirit willing to learn and grow under the direction of the Director, ChangePoint Pastor of Campus Ministries, and other ChangePoint leadership.
- ❖ They must be a team player willing to collaborate, healthily challenge, and contribute to the overall ministry.
- ❖ They must be actively growing spiritually both in the context of ministry and as the leader of their home, marriage, and family (as appropriate).
- ❖ They must be a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ and committed to the ChangePoint vision of bringing life in Christ to every Alaskan and the world beyond.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ Help cultivate a gospel-focused community in Marshall.
- ❖ Facilitate, in concert with the Marshall Director and ChangePoint Kotzebue CP, Christ-honoring services each Sunday.
- ❖ Provide daily discipleship, community, and encouragement to the Marshall church family.
- ❖ Maintain a welcoming spirit that draws people of all ages and backgrounds to Christ.
- ❖ Continually cast vision that points people to life in Christ.
- ❖ Must raise support to fund stipend and personal expenses.

- ❖ Lead a life that represents Christ in an authentic and compelling manner.
- ❖ Demonstrate an integrated understanding of the Scriptures.
- ❖ Demonstrate a passion and vision for discipleship in the context of highly relational, gospel-centered communities.
