 5. Does the Bible promise a pain-free life?
 6. How does the gospel reveal itself anew during grief-filled seasons?
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Surrender: *Responding to God's voice.*

7. Take a moment as a group to support one another -- Is there any "grief" in this group that we can process together?
8. Who in your lives (outside of the group) is going through a season of grief that could use support from the group?
9. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
