Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read 2:1-14*

1. What did Elijah tell Elisha to do?
2. What was Elisha’s response?
3. What did Elisha ask of Elijah?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

4. Where do you see Elisha’s commitment to the call?
5. What’s your personal response to Elisha’s request for a double portion? Would you have the boldness to answer that way after seeing all Elijah had to journey through?
6. What “baton” is being placed in your hand?
7. What’s the courageous step you need to take to run with that baton?

Surrender: *Responding to God’s voice.*

8. How can we, as a group, pray for boldness and courage over one another today?
9. How can we, as a group, keep one another accountable to the call to courage this week?
10. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
