Small Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read 2 Kings 6:8-23*

1. How did Israel learn of the king of Syria’s plan?
2. How many times did Elisha pray for eyes to be opened?
3. Did Elisha give the king of Israel permission to strike down the Syrian army?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

4. Why was Elisha’s servant overwhelmed? What, in your personal life, feels like the army of Syria surrounding you?
5. In whatever’s surrounding your life, what might you *not* see? Spend time helping another “open your eyes” in your situation.
6. What are you resting in for your success or failure?
7. Elizabeth Elliot said, “Fear arises when we imagine everything depends upon us.” What fears do you have that may be coming from you owning more than you should?

Surrender: *Responding to God’s voice.*

8. How can we, as a group, release our need for revenge and “justice” to the Lord?
9. How can we, as a group, keep one another accountable to the call to being modern-day prophets this week?
10. What is one thing God said to you through this series?
