Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read Matthew 6:19-24*

1. We are commanded to NOT lay up treasures where?
 2. We are commanded TO lay up treasures where?
 3. How many masters can someone serve?
 4. Which part of the body determines whether our entire body will be full of light or darkness?
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Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures?*

How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

5. Spend some time talking about “stuff” and the way of Jesus . . . do the two ideas mix?
 6. Be honest . . . do you have a problem with building the kingdom of (insert your name here)?
 7. Do you have a vision for kingdom treasure? If so, take a moment to share a little bit about what you ‘see.’
 8. Take a moment to share an example of when you surrendered earthly treasure for kingdom treasure.
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Surrender: *Responding to God’s voice.*

9. How can we as a group inspire a vision for kingdom treasure together?
10. How can we as a group hold each other accountable to choosing the right Master?
11. As a group, take some time for repentance and prayer.
