**Getting Started**

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.  
Expect God to move through your time together!

**Pacing Your Group**

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

**Scripture Reading**

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

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**Observation: *What do the scripture passages say? Read Luke Luke:27-32***

1. What does Levi do in response to Jesus saying, “Follow me,” and what details does Luke give that show the significance of his response?
2. Who does Levi invite to his banquet, and how do the Pharisees and scribes respond to Jesus eating with them?
3. What does Jesus’ comparison of sinners to sick people who need a doctor reveal about why He came and whom He came to call?

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**Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts flowing from the scriptures? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?***

4. Peter and Levi came from very different worlds but had the same spiritual condition. What kinds of people or sins are you most tempted to view as “worse” or farther from Jesus than you are?
5. Levi “left everything” to follow Jesus. What area of your life is most difficult for you to place completely under Jesus’ authority?
6. Levi’s old relationships became his new mission field. Who has God already placed in your life that may need an opportunity to encounter Jesus?
7. What is one practical way you could “make room at your table” this week—through a meal, coffee, conversation, invitation, or simply time—to help that person move closer to Jesus?

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**Surrender: *Responding to God’s voice.***

8. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
