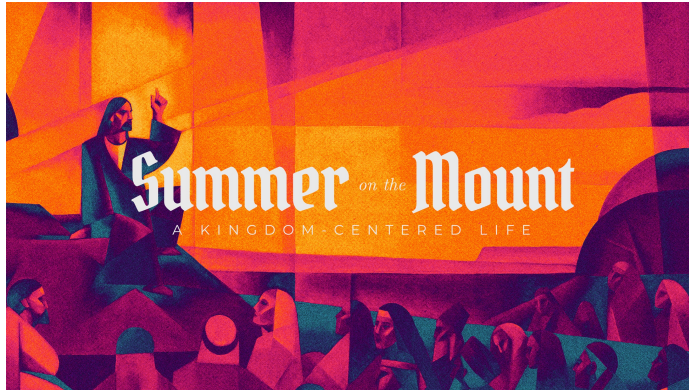

Group Discussion Questions

Getting Started

Take some time to catch up and connect as a group. Pray before discussion.
Expect God to move through your time together!

Pacing Your Group

Move quickly through “observation” leaving enough time for “reflection”, “discussion”, and “surrender.”

Scripture Reading

Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: *What does the scripture say?*

Read Matthew 6:7-13

1. Jesus tells us not to “babble” as we pray. What does he mean?
2. What does Jesus’ prayer teach us about God?
3. What does his prayer tell us about ourselves?
4. How often does Jesus imply we should pray?

Reflection and Discussion: *What are some first thoughts? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?*

5. How should the fact that “God knows what you need before you ask” impact our prayers?
6. Do the topics and/or the order of what Jesus prays suggest a model that we should use? How important might that be?
7. What are you most praying for right now?

Application: *What is God saying to you?*

8. What is one thing God is saying to you through this study and discussion?
