Re-read the scripture passages as needed when you discuss the questions.

Observation: What does the scripture say?

Read 2 Kings 4:8-36

1. What stands out to you in this story?
 2. How did God build Elisha’s spiritual credibility with the Shunammite woman?
 3. Where can we see evidence that God was giving Elisha words that would bring life to her?
 4. How did God leverage Elisha’s relationship with her to help them both experience his grace?
 5. Where do we see either Elisha or the woman struggle to have faith in God? How successful were they in finding it?

Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?

6. In what ways do you identify with Elisha in this story?
 7. In what ways do you relate with the woman?
 8. Where do you need God to empower your ability to share spiritual truth with people?
 9. With whom do you want God to give you spiritual credibility? How might he do that?
 10. Can you think of someone who God might want you to bring words of life?
 11. What struggles to have faith are you experiencing as God’s messenger?
