**Observation: What does the scripture say?**

**Read 2 Kings 4**

1. Do the slave girl and Elisha treat Naaman as a foreigner and enemy?
  2. Do the slave girl and Elisha require Naaman to do something to deserve love and concern from them?
  3. Do the slave girl and Elisha hope to gain personally from demonstrating love and concern for Naaman?
  4. How does Gehazi fail to love Naaman?
  5. How does Elisha respond to Gehazi’s sin and failure?

**Reflection and Discussion: What are some first thoughts? How do the scriptures connect to everyday life?**

6. In what ways do you identify with Elisha in this story?
  7. In what ways do you relate to Gehazi or the king of Israel?
  8. Do you struggle more to love people with grace or with “tough love?”
  9. Where do you need God to empower you to love people like he does?
