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Overview of activities

We are so grateful for God's grace to us in 2025. Lives were changed, people were impacted, we continued to grow as a family in numbers and maturity, although we still have a long way to go.

The people of Redeemer continued to be generous and we were able to do all that we planned to do. As leaders and staff in the church, we sought to steward the money entrusted to the church well, and to operate in line with the church's goals and objectives.

Key Gatherings

The most important ongoing events in our church life continued to be the Sunday worship services, connect groups and prayer meetings. These activities form the basis of what we do and we have seen God wonderfully at work during these times. From September, we started a second Dutch language service so as to better reach Dutch people in our city with the love of Jesus.

Kids, Youth and Young Adults

Kids groups functioned well through the year and moved to the basement of the Nieuwe Kerk in new spaces. Another part-time person was employed to lead kids work in the Dutch service. We were able to finally employ a youth leader and we were able to see continued momentum in young adults, both in numbers and life groups.

Loving our Neighbour

This ministry gained considerable momentum through 2025. Church members were mobilised and equipped to serve people impacted by poverty, marginalisation and/or injustice in The Hague and financial support was given to different aligned organisations.

Love Nations

Through our Love Nations initiative we were able to support the excellent work of the New Ground family of Churches and 'Disciple Nations'¹ in Mozambique.

Love People

Through our Love People Fund we were able to financially support members of our church family who faced financial hardship.

Church Plants

Redeemer continued to focus on our desire to plant more churches and Henty and Sophia joined us in order to spend time in Redeemer before planting a church into Eindhoven.

Wider Connections

Redeemer is a part of the New Ground family of churches. This connection continues to be very important to us.

Financial statements

During the year the work of the church was provided for by the grace of God and through the continued support of its members who gave generously their time, energy and financial resources.

Overview

Total income in 2025 increased to €832,648 (+13%) while expenses of €800,401 (+11%) also increased across all categories, most notably in donations to €184,606 from €126,665.

Expenses

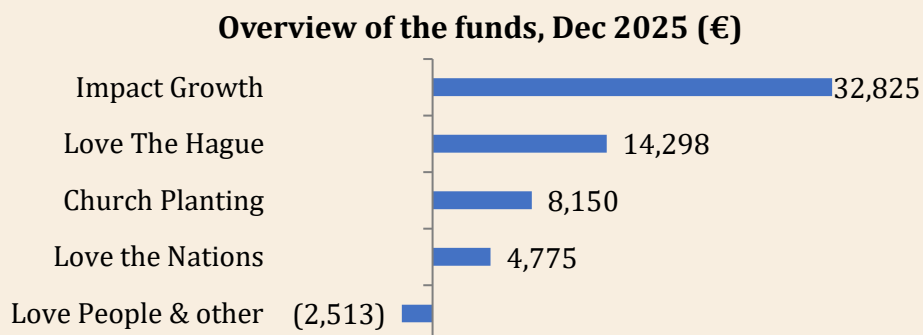
The main expense categories were employment costs, which accounted for 45% of total costs, followed by office and church meetings expenses 22%.

Net result

The net result difference between total income and total expenses shows a surplus of €32,446. This consists of a loss of € 4,745 for the activities of Redeemer International Church and a positive result of Other Assets allocated to the accounts of Redeemer International Church.

Financial position

As of end 2025 the church's current financial assets were €275,927 most of which in bank deposits. Financial liabilities amounted to €58,464, while special-purpose reserves in various funds to be distributed in the coming years were €57,535.



By the grace of God, Redeemer International Church remains in a good financial position to be able to continue its mission of spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ, to account for potentially unexpected expenses, and to be able to respond in giving to the purposes which God might call us to.
