Gods Council!

Gal 5:25 Since it is through the Spirit that we have Life, let it also be through the Spirit that we order our lives day by day.

- For us to use and apply:

John 15:26 "When the Counselor comes, whom I will send you from the Father — the Spirit of Truth, who keeps going out from the Father — he will testify on my behalf.

- Wisdom and Council from Yeshua:

John 16:7 But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I don't go away, the comforting Counselor will not come to you. However, if I do go, I will send him to you.

- A Prophecy about Yeshua:

Isa 9:6 (9:5) For a child is born to us, a son is given to us; dominion will rest on his shoulders, and he will be given the name Pele-Yo`etz El Gibbor Avi-`Ad Sar-Shalom [Wonder of a Counselor, Mighty God, Father of Eternity, Prince of Peace],

- Wisdom from God:

Isa 28:29 This too comes from Adonai-Tzva'ot — his counsel is wonderful, his wisdom great.

Appreciation of what we have!

- A radical and revolutionary prophecy and idea:
Joel 2:28-29 (3:1-2) "After this, I will pour out my Spirit on all humanity. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions; and also on male and female slaves in those days I will pour out my Spirit.
- Only a select few had the Spirit, Leaders, Prophets, Kings etc...
Mat 3:11 It's true that I am immersing you in water so that you might turn from sin to God; but the one coming after me is more powerful than I — I'm not worthy even to carry his sandals — and he will immerse you in the Ruach HaKodesh and in fire.

The Spirit of Prophecy:

- The Spirit that John was referencing (Holy Spirit & Fire) that we were going to be immersed into was through Yeshua, given to His followers on Shavu'ot (Pentecost). **Acts 2**

Rev 19:10 Then I fell down at his feet and worshiped him. But he said to me, “See that you do not do that—for I am only a fellow servant with you and your brothers and sisters who hold to the testimony of Yeshua. Worship God! For the testimony of Yeshua is the Spirit of Prophecy.”

- Through Yeshua, the Holy Spirit will part to us the Spirit of Prophecy

What is Prophecy:

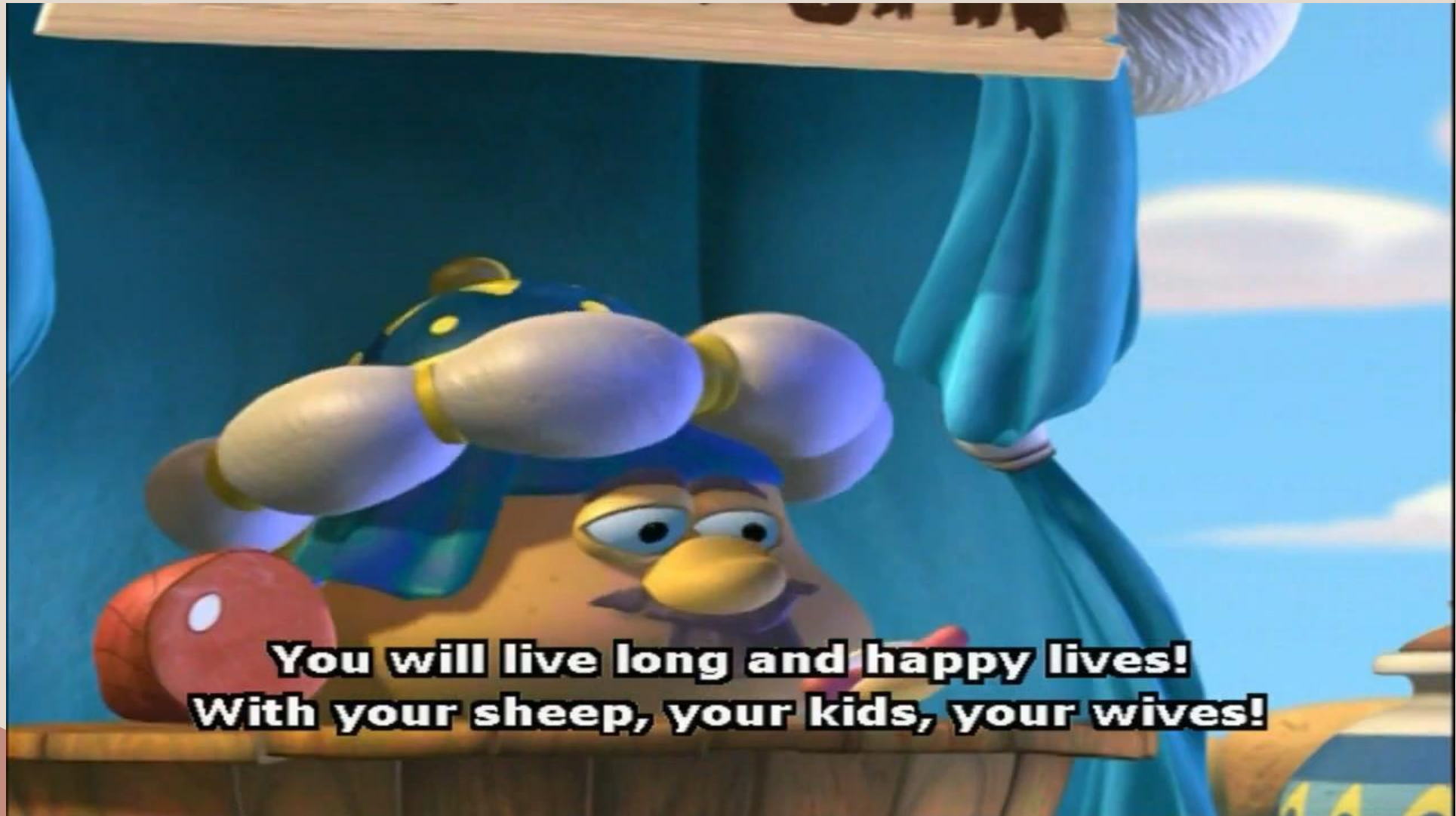
- Prophet: H5030 “Navi” נְבִיא “Inspired Man”
- Prophecy: H5016 “Navuah” נְבוּאָה “Prediction spoken or written”
- Root word: H5012 “Naba” נָבָא “To speak or sing by inspiration”
- Greek “Prophetia” Root: G4396 “Profetace” “Inspired Speaker”

Num 24:13 even if Balak would give me his palace full of silver and gold,
I could not of my own accord go beyond the word of Adonai to do
either good or bad? that what Adonai said is what I would say?

What is Prophecy:

- Prophecy ALWAYS comes forth in a KNOWN LANGUAGE!
 - **Acts 2:11** (Simple prophecy in a foreign but known language).
- Prophecy does NOT always come forth foretelling the future.
- Prophecy is ALWAYS a word from the throne of God, from God himself.
- Sometimes its simply a light or reveling into a current situation, word of wisdom.
- An inspired word from God! Meant for edification.

What is Prophecy: Veggie Tales



Examples in Scripture:

- Examples in scripture of prophecy that does not foretell the future:

Exo 15:20-21 Also Miryam the prophet, sister of Aharon, took a tambourine in her hand; and all the women went out after her with tambourines, dancing, as Miryam sang to them: "Sing to Adonai, for he is highly exalted! The horse and its rider he threw in the sea!"

- No new revelation, no foretelling, events already happened (Just took place).

What is Prophecy?

- The Spirit of Prophecy is available to us daily! (Simple Prophecy)
- Inspired words from God, Psalms and songs.
- Lifts, changes the atmosphere!
- Inspired prophecy: Many times, when teaching we'll go down trail not originally intentioned. Freely flow from God through “the structure”.

Mat 10:8 Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with tza'arat, drive out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

Prophecy is an **INSPIRED** word!

- Read Hannah's inspired prayer: **1Sam 2:1-11**
- Commonly referred to as "simple prophecy"
- An inspired word. She was inspired to say this!
- Mostly a generally praising of the Lord.
- Some prediction of the future...
- Praying in the Spirit is an inspired word just like prophecy!
- If its futuristic, then it also contains a word of wisdom.

Prophecy is an **INSPIRED** word!

Luke 1:46-56 Then Miryam said, "My soul magnifies Adonai; and my spirit rejoices in God, my Savior, who has taken notice of his servant-girl in her humble position. For — imagine it! — from now on, all generations will call me blessed! "The Mighty One has done great things for me! Indeed, his name is holy; and in every generation he has mercy on those who fear him. "He has performed mighty deeds with his arm, routed the secretly proud, brought down rulers from their thrones, raised up the humble, filled the hungry with good things, but sent the rich away empty. "He has taken the part of his servant Isra'el, mindful of the mercy which he promised to our fathers, to Avraham and his seed forever." Miryam stayed with Elisheva for about three months and then returned home.

- A little revelation, mostly recanting Gods goodness and promises.
- An anointing to describe who He is and what He does!

Inspired words from God:

It's important to understand that a person can prophecy and not say anything in a revelatory nature. You can be giving God praise generally and you are extolling God with an anointing to describe who he is and what he does. You are under an unction to say these things. Magnifying god lifts the inner man, your spirit and the spirit will assist you in this. Under the spirit of prophecy, we end up saying things that are beyond our comprehension.

Scriptural Examples:

LUKE 7:24-28 AND AFTER JOHN'S MESSENGERS LEFT, HE BEGAN TO SPEAK ABOUT JOHN TO THE CROWDS. "WHAT DID YOU GO OUT TO THE WILDERNESS TO SEE? A REED SHAKEN BY THE WIND? NO? SO WHAT DID YOU GO OUT TO SEE? A MAN DRESSED IN FINE GARMENTS? LOOK, THOSE WHO WEAR FINERY AND LIVE IN LUXURY ARE IN THE PALACES OF KINGS! THEN WHAT DID YOU GO OUT TO SEE? A PROPHET? YES, I TELL YOU, EVEN MORE THAN A PROPHET. THIS IS THE ONE ABOUT WHOM IT IS WRITTEN, 'BEHOLD, I SEND MY MESSENGER BEFORE YOU, WHO WILL PREPARE YOUR WAY BEFORE YOU.' I SAY TO YOU, THERE IS NO ONE GREATER THAN JOHN AMONG THOSE BORN OF WOMEN; YET THE LEAST IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS GREATER THAN HE."

- JOHN DID NO "MIRACULOUS SIGNS"...
- "REPENT FOR THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN IS AT HAND" – AN INSPIRED WORD!

Scriptural Examples:

- Jerimiah was a great prophet!
- He did foretell the future, but he did no “miracles”.
- Anointed to announce Gods judgment to kings & nations.

- Sampson was an anointed Judge!
- He did many miracles and His strength was from God.
- He did little prophesying.

- God manifests his gifts in different ways depending on the person, the need, the time, and setting for what it is they are to do.

Prophecy

- John's function was to point people to the Messiah and preach repentance – not some spectacular revelatory word!
- You can prophecy with an anointing to sing the psalms or declare God's greatness it's lifting just doing that!
- The point I am making is that “simple prophecy” doesn't have to have revelation in it. We think prophecy is always foretelling the future ~ it doesn't have to. It's a “Message from the Lord”

What's the purpose of Prophecy?

1Cor 14:3-4 But one who prophesies speaks to people for building up (EDIFICATION), urging on (EXORTATION), and uplifting (COMFORTING). One who speaks in a tongue builds up himself, but one who prophesies builds up the community.

1. Building up – Edification (Charge, uplift)
2. Urging on – Exhortation (Reminder to get it done)
3. Uplifting – Comforting (Not confusion or torment – Guide)

What's the purpose of Prophecy?

- We tend to always want something new and exotic, never heard before, sensational! We shouldn't expect those things, rather we should seek to hear Gods word and desire for each situation. To Edify, Exhort and Comfort!

1Jn 2:7 Loved ones, I am not writing a new commandment for you, but an old commandment—one you had from the beginning. This old commandment is the word you have heard.

Mat 13:51-52 “Have you understood all these things?” They said to Him, “Yes.” Then He said to them, “Therefore every Torah scholar disciplined for the kingdom of heaven is like the master of a household who brings out of his treasure both new things and old.” — 17

Praying with the Spirit:

- Praying in the Spirit can be in an unknown language (Privately to yourself) prophecy is always in a known language.
- Read **1Corinthians 14:1-19**
 - Pursue love – Greatest commandment
 - This is done by recharging your love (Personal prayer)
 - So that we can prophecy in a known tongue to edify the body (Public)
 - We must choose to pursue it – study for later...
- An inspired word from Yahweh has an amazing power to refresh and stimulate you!
