# Abide:

SUMMER IN  
THE GOSPELS

In John 15, Jesus calls Himself the True Vine and describes us as the branches. He makes it clear that we were created to bear fruit but warns: “apart from Me you can do nothing” (v. 5). To live the abundant life He promises, we must abide—the daily practice of staying connected to Him. For the next 90 days, we will focus on two ways to do that:

rooting our lives in His Word and lifting our needs up in confident, expectant prayer.

Use this 90-day plan to stay connected to the **True Vine** every single day. To get the most out of your time, consider following this REAP rhythm:

- Read: Read your daily passage slowly, looking for the main point.
- Examine: Consider what the passage reveals about Jesus and His character.
- Apply: Ask, “How does this change how I think or act today?” and identify one specific step of obedience.
- Pray: Talk to God about what you learned, bringing your needs to Him with the confidence that He hears you.

My prayer is that, whether you’re at home or traveling this summer, you experience a deep, abiding relationship with Jesus as you live in the overflow of his strength. I can’t wait to see the fruit He produces in us!
