Who leads Sonshine Club?

Sonshine Clubs throughout San Diego are sponsored by Sonshine Haven, a non-profit organization started in 1993. The clubs at Jamacha and Jamul School are led by Jamul Community Church. All volunteers have gone through a thorough application and training process, and are excited to serve at club.

What will my child be learning?

Children will learn from the greatest book ever written, the Bible, God's love letter to us. From the beginning of the Bible to the last page we see his love and care for us. This year we will learn about God through the lives of people in the Bible. Each week there will be a handout about what the children have specifically learned along with the memory verse. Children can recite the verse the next week for a reward. Once they have recited 3 verses they will earn a special prize such as a 7/11 Slurpee, Menchie's yogurt or Cain's meal. Remember, the greatest reward is learning the words of truth from the Bible. Most weeks the 5th graders will be learning the lesson in their own small group with a leader to guide them in discovering Bible truths for themselves.

What are the behavioral expectations for my child?

During club we have a lot of fun together, but the only way everyone can have fun together is if everyone is respectful. We have four rules at Sonshine Club, **Respect God, Respect the Leaders, Respect Each Other, and HAVE FUN!!** If someone is

continually disobeying these rules that child will be asked to take a “reset,” a two week break from Sonshine Club. Parents will be contacted when a “reset” is being considered. Following the rules will be affirmed and rewarded during every club. One way that is done is with “Sonshine Bucks.” When a child has 10 Sonshine Bucks they can “buy” a small prize.

What is the check in/out process?

Jamacha School:

- Check in directly after school in the Multi-purpose room.
- Check out is at 2pm in the Multi-purpose room.
- Children participating in EDP will stay with Sonshine Club staff until moving to EDP.

Jamul School:

- Check in directly after school at the grass area between the SPED office and Kinder rooms.
- Once children are checked in we will be walking together to the GSDA campus learning center.
- Pick up at 4pm at the GSDA campus in the learning center. (If GSDA parking lot is closed children will be walked back by Sonshine Club staff to Jamul Elementary parking lot for pick up at 4pm.)
- Children participating in Champions will be walked back by Sonshine Club staff to Jamul Elementary campus and afterschool club..

Both Schools: ARRIVING ON TIME to pick up your children is necessary and greatly appreciated!

How do I sign my child up?

Fill out the registration form provided at www.jamul.org/kidsworld or in your school office and bring to club. Children must have a signed permission slip to participate in club.
