



MEMORIAL PARK CHURCH IS SEEKING A CHILDCARE WORKER

Purpose

To assist parents as they invite their children to learn to Love People. Know Jesus. Live Transformed.

Qualifications

- Early Childhood Education Experience or certifications desirable.
- Possesses strong relational skills; the ability to build positive relationships with children, parents, supervisor, and church staff.
- Experience in ministering to children preferred.
- An affirming faith in Jesus Christ.

Accountability

- The Childcare Worker will report to the Early Childhood Coordinator.
- The Childcare Worker shall work collegially with the Children's Ministries Staff members and other volunteers.

Position Status

- As needed, primarily 2-3 hours per shift, up to three shifts per week during the school year.
- Sunday mornings year round, Tuesday mornings or Wednesday evenings from September to early May
- Optional special events as needed

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

- Provide childcare in a safe and nurturing environment for young children during various church-wide ministries
- Nurture children's spiritual development by demonstrating prayer before snack, incorporating music and stories to grow kids' faith and wonder of God's creation.
- Work with the Early Childhood Coordinator to provide practical and developmentally appropriate activities and crafts for children.
- Clean toys as needed.
- Notify Early Childhood Coordinator about any broken toys or equipment, or lack of snacks or supplies in the classroom.
- Participate in yearly training.
- Encourage families to participate in the life of the church.

Personal Characteristics

- Passionate about teaching children about Christ, possessing a desire to come alongside parents through loving and caring for their children.
- Patient with children of all ages and abilities; enthusiastic to try different behavioral approaches. Gentle, humble, genuine, honest, service-oriented, approachable personality and relationship- building skills.
